Ships to Launch Guided Missiles

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The Navy awarded Monday a 30-million dollar contract for converting two heavy cruisers into guided missile ships.

Rear Admiral Homer N. Wallin, chief of the Navy Bureau of Ships, said the two vessels—the 13,600-ton cruisers Boston and Canberra—will be converted at the New York Shipbuilding Corp., Camden, N. J.



Both the Boston and Canberra are veterans of many engagements in the Pacific during World War II. They were in the reserve fleet at the Puget Sound, Wash., Naval Shipyard at Bremerton before starting their journey to Camden.

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
