

Seaman Chained On Ship 67 Days

SEATTLE—Attorneys for the Ishman Steamship Co., said Thursday a seaman chained to his ship's bridge for 67 days was the ringleader of a "mutiny-minded crew."

William M. Olynik, 27, New Westminster, B. C., the seaman, sought \$100,000 damages for the company, in a civil suit being tried in Superior Court. He claimed his confinement on the steamer Clyde L. Seavey during a voyage half-way around the world was "cruel and inhuman."

"I felt pretty rotten when we went into ports and I was plainly visible to natives and crews of other ships while chained to the deck," Olynik testified Wednesday.
