## Timber Firm's Forester Tells How Sustained Unit Operates

"Sustained yield is the gearing of your plant to the productivity of the supporting tree farm" is the simple definition given the term by Robert Gehrman, chief forester of the Springfield branch of the Weyerhaeuser Timber Company.

Gehrman addressed members of the Exchange Club Tuesday.

HE ILLUSTRATED his remarks with a map of a sustained yield "unit" near Sutherlin. The company has earmarked various parts of the unit for cutting at staggered dates and plans to complete harvest of all the timber in one hundred years, re-seeding cut areas as it goes along.

Gehrman said plans for the cutting schedule are arrived at after consideration of several factors: growth rate of the trees, configuration of the county roads, plant capacity and type of timber needed on the market. He said four-fifths of the company's timber is over-ripe.

After determination of the cutting schedule, logging is carried out in such a way that no "seed block" is more than one fourth of a mile from a logged off portion. Gehrman explained that seed will
