Opposition Wants
Government to Quit

PORTTOWN, South Africa—(AP)—An opposition leader told thousands Wednesday that the South African people would meet force with force if the government tried to suppress the nationalist movement and then tries to get them out with autocratic methods.

Reporters of three opposition groups formed a united front at a meeting in Capetown City Hall and on the government to resign. Observers said it was the first meeting here in 25 years. A rally was called to oppose Minister Daniel F. Malan's intention of curbing the power of South Africa's high court, which has ruled out a law in the government's social supremacy program.

G. N. Strauss, leader of the N. Party, chief opposition, read a declaration promising the united front "to fight the restoration of democratic government in South Africa."

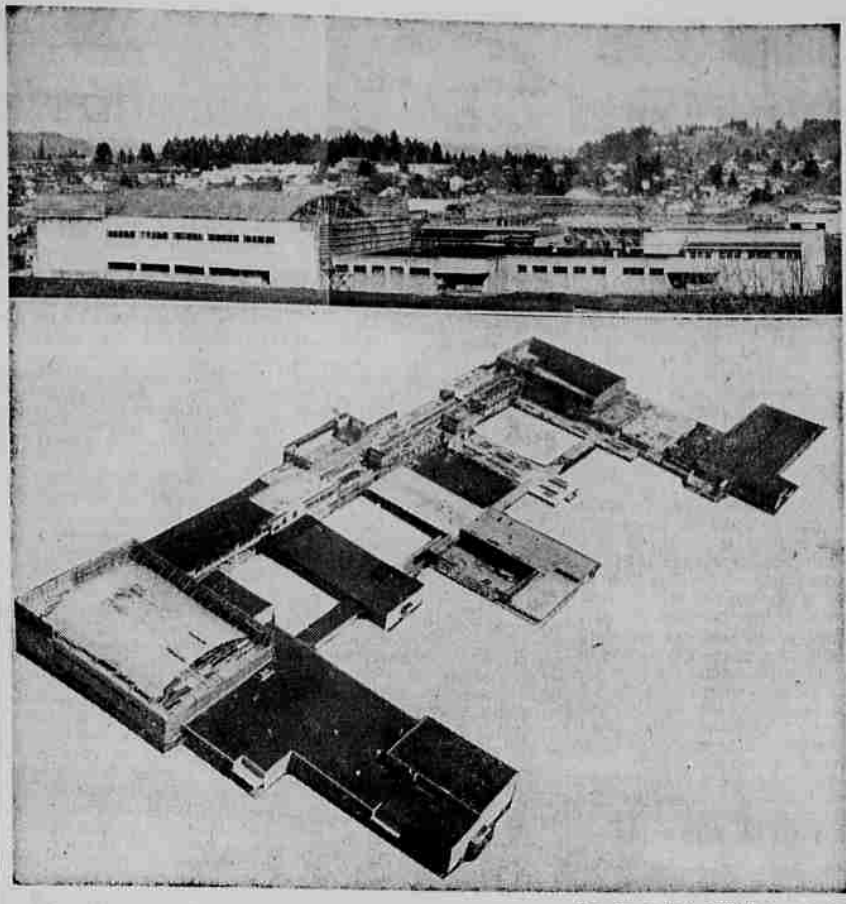
Strauss implied that Malan's cabinet following hoped to incidents that would lead to a breakdown.

Police Report Month's Work

Basic rule infractions accounted for the majority of moving violations arrests made by the Springfield Police Department during March, according to a report on the month's police activities released Wednesday by Chief of Police Harry W. Howard.

The traffic analysis showed 49 basic rule violations; 12 stop sign; one reckless driving; one driving under the influence of liquor; one hit and run and 80 miscellaneous non-moving violations.

There were 45 accidents investigated by police and two persons were injured. No deaths occurred in accidents.

In the category of offenses against public peace, 21 drunks were listed as booked in. Five arrests were made for disorderly conduct, five for vagrancy, one for contributing to delinquency of a minor; one NSF check; and one escape from custody. Twelve juvenile delinquency cases were handled.

Four auto thefts were reported. One of these was cleared and one proved to be unfounded.
