The Red Cross bloodmobile will be in Florence Thursday, following the Wednesday appointment in Creswell.

The Florence collection, for all residents in the area, will be the only collection on the coast this spring. Hours will be from noon to 6 p. m. at the VFW hall.

Coast residents may register with Mrs. Walter Severy. Sponsoring the collection is the VFW and all clubs and civic organizations in the Florence area. Quota is 200 pints.

There will not be a collection this spring in the Mapleton area, the local Red Cross office has announced. Mapleton residents will be asked to visit Florence Thursday to give blood.

Police Report Crime Down During March

March was pretty much of a routine month for Eugene's police force. If somewhat shorthanded due to a recent flurry of resignations, the department got a compensating break with a continued ebb in criminal activity.

Only six burglaries occurred in the city during March, and grand larceny cases dropped to four as compared with the previous month's 13.

Accident investigations, too, dropped off. In February officers were called to check into 84 street mishaps. Those involved injuries to 14 persons and an estimated \$18,225 in property damage.

March's traffic score shows only 64 accident investigations, seven injuries and property loss amounting to \$16,990.

Parking meter collections for the month increased during March, however. In fact, the meters yielded

\$8190—the second highest total on record.

Municipal court receipts, on the other hand, dropped to \$11,283, as compared with \$13,490 in February.

The police department's March report indicates that 43 juveniles were involved in incidents investigated by officers.

Of that total, 38 were boys, five girls. Seven rioteers were picked up; 11 youngsters cited for illegal possession of alcohol; 11 taken off the streets for curfew violations; four arrested for larceny; three charged with vandalism, and three more with being drunk.

Mrs. Ann Henke, 25, whose husband Edmund attended the International Economic Conference in Moscow, said:

The streets were colorless and the people were colorless. The women all wore dark blues or dark grey. There wasn't much laughing, no playfulness. Every woman I saw seemed to be moving fast and purposefully."
