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WASHINGTON — (AP) — Gen. Mark W. Clark left by plane for Tokyo Monday to start a shift in high commands which will bring Gen. Eisenhower home to the political campaigns and send Gen. Matthew Ridgway from the Far East to Paris as military chief of the Western powers.

Clark said, before leaving, that his job in the Far East was to "obtain an honorable armistice." The Defense Department announced, meanwhile, that Ridgway will arrive in San Francisco May 13 enroute to Paris, where he will succeed Gen. Eisenhower.

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BLM Announces Salvage Program

WASHINGTON — The Bureau of Land Management plans to offer Oregon's private timber owners "emergency licenses" good for one-year access rights across O & C lands for strictly salvage operations, according to Director Marion Clawson.

The proposal was described by Roscoe E. Bell, BLM director for Region 1, Portland, as a "significant departure" but not a fundamental change in the normal policy of requiring long term reciprocal agreements from private landowners in return for access rights across public lands.

The emergency licenses are to be granted by BLM district managers after applications have been reviewed by local O & C advisory boards. Special application forms are to be made available subsequently.

"We are going to operate the program in a goldfish bowl," Clawson said, "to avoid any charges of favoritism in giving these short-term rights-of-way."

THE LICENSES would be good for one year and not be renewable, Bell declared, but additional licenses might be granted if salvage harvesting has not been completed in the first year.

Salvage operations were described by BLM as follows:

(1) may include the removal of sound intermingled or adjacent trees provided that (1) either the total volume of the trees to be removed does not exceed 100,000 bd. ft. or (2) where removal of sound trees is physically required by normal logging practices or is economically necessary to make a minimum practicable logging operation, the volume of such sound timber shall not exceed the volume of the (salvage) timber."

A timber tract to qualify for an emergency license must have been classified by the Bureau of Entomology and Plant Quarantine as a danger zone for Douglas fir beetle or by the State Forestry Department, or BLM as an area requiring fire hazard reduction.

BLM SAID THE program was drafted in anticipation of requests from private timber owners for such short-term access rights. The proposal has previously been discussed with Frank Sever, counsel for the Association of O & C Counties; Reginald Titus, executive secretary of the Western Forest Industries Assn. and Stewart Mair of the Western Forestry and Conservation Assn. None had any "fundamental objection to issuance of short-term access right in bona fide salvage situations," the bureau said.

"This is an expression of co-operation with private landowners to help meet this emergency situation," Bell declared. He said at a meeting last night of the Northwest Forest Pest committee it was revealed that the salvage problem caused by last year's fire and wind storms is "much more serious than anticipated."

Clawson and Bell testified Friday before the Senate Appropriations Committee in support of a recent request for \$2,750,000 to finance BLM salvage operations on its lands in Oregon, Washington and California, largely in O & C timber.

Clark Leaves, Starts Shifts

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Tone, Barbara Meet in Court

LOS ANGELES — (AP) — Compared with the preliminaries, it was very peaceful when Barbara Payton and Franchot Tone met in court Monday.

Indications of a settlement of their differences were in the air and her attorney, Milton M. Golden, told the court:

"Although it's Monday, and it's washday, there'll be no dirty linen washed in this court today."

Superior Judge Mildred Lillie continued the case until May 12.

Lawyers said Tone's petition to amend his divorce complaint to charge Miss Payton with adultery with actor Tom Neal, scheduled for hearing in another court Tuesday, will be called off.

Tone and the blonde actress were married last September, 10 days after the actor was beaten by Neal in a dispute over Miss Payton. The marriage lasted just 53 days. Both are now suing for divorce.

RR Benefits Boosted

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The House Monday unanimously passed and sent to the White House a bill to raise the rates of benefits under the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act. New rates would range from \$3 to \$7.50 a day, replacing present rates ranging from \$1.75 to \$5 a day, depending on the rate of earnings of the employee.

The roll call vote was 40 to 33 in favor of the motion of Sen. Sen. Knowland (R-Calif.) to refer the big measure to Armed Services with instructions to send it back to the floor by May 15.

General debate on it had been scheduled to begin Monday.

But Knowland said the bill should go to Armed Services because 70 per cent of the money was for direct military purposes.

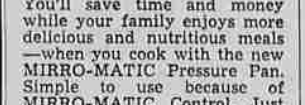
The Armed Services Committee should consider whether greater reductions could be made and whether military equipment destined for foreign allies is depriving U. S. forces of needed material, the Californian argued.

BUFFALO, N. Y. — (AP) — Sister Mary Fidelis said Tuesday she hopes she may temporarily take the place of Babe Ruth as the idol of her students because she dared to go for a ride in a helicopter.

She was among 10 nuns who visited the Bell plant at Niagara Falls Monday and won the ride in a drawing of names from a hat. It was believed that Sister Fidelis became the first nun ever to ride in a "windmill."

West Germans Name Anthem

BONN, Germany — (AP) — President Theodor Heuss Tuesday proclaimed "Deutschland Ueber Alles" (Germany over all) as the national anthem of West Germany.

Heuss made the proclamation in an exchange of letters with Chancellor Konrad Adenauer. He said he did not wish to make a "ceremonial proclamation," but suggested merely that the Bonn Republic simply should "recognize the facts of the case."

The nationalistic hymn thus became West Germany's official anthem seven years after the World War II capitulation of Adolf Hitler's "Thousand Year Reich."

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
