

Tight Major Camps and Trips Planned for Area's Boy Scouts

Eight major camps and trip sessions are scheduled for the summer for Oregon Trail Council area Scouts and Explorers.

However, some of the camps will be operated only if enough Scouts sign up.

Camp Melakwa, on Lake Melakwa near Scott Lake in the Kenzie area 75 miles up the Kenzie River, will serve as the in council camp.

It will be open July 20 to 26, Aug. 2 to Aug. 3 to Aug. 9.

A central water supply system is to be installed this year to be used by each troop site.

CAMP LITTLE RIVER, on the Little River about 35 miles east of Roseburg, will be open June 29 to July 5 if at least five troops register.

A pack of about a quarter of a mile necessary to get into the camp. Camp Solholm, about 25 miles north of Coos Bay on Ten Mile River near Highway 101, is scheduled to be open July 6 to July 12, at least five troops with 50 Scouts register.

Cars cannot be taken into camp.

SWIMMING, canoeing and canoeing are available at Camp Melakwa, but either not possible or limited at Little River and Solholm.

Marksmanship activities are available at Melakwa, but not at the others. Most other Scouting activities and skills can be practiced at all three camps.

The Umpqua Canoe Trip is scheduled twice, from June 22 to 28, and from June 29 to July 5. This trip, for Explorer Scouts only, is a rugged jaunt from Roseburg to the sea down the Umpqua River. Each trip is limited to 32 Explorers and leaders. All registering must meet swimming requirements and must have a physical exam using the standard Scout form.

Physicals are also required for Melakwa.

EXPLORES' CREWS from any one post are urged to come as an organized unit. An attempt will be made to assign one canoe to the unit.

The annual trek along the Skyline Trail this year will be from Aug. 16 to 24, starting at Santiam Lodge and ending at Breitenbush. A little shorter trip this year than in some past years, the trek will pass several fine fishing streams and lakes in the Cascades, Scout executives say.

Darwin Reese, Corvallis, will lead the trek.

Fees are required for some camps and trips. Detailed information on any of the trips, or for independent troop camps and "touring camps" outside the council area, can be obtained from the Oregon Trail Council Office in the U. S. National Bank Building in Eugene.

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
