

Two 'Defeated' Delegates Win Johnson and Fowler In On Official Count

SALEM — (AP) — Two candidates, believed beaten in last week's election, emerged winners in the race for delegates to the Republican National Convention.

The two—Dr. Frank E. Fowler, Oregon, and State Rep. J. O. Johnson, Tigard—will replace ex-Senator Leslie M. Scott and Mrs. Zylpha Zell Burns, chief of the state Senate, on the list of the 10 winning candidates.

SCOTT and Mrs. Burns, both of Portland, were believed winners of the ninth and tenth positions on the basis of incomplete returns from the May 16 primary election.

But Friday Dave O'Hara, state registrar of elections, made an official count of the votes from counties which have not yet turned in their official results. The vote from these four counties gave the election to Fowler and Johnson.

THE COMPLETE but unofficial returns show these 10 candidates to be winners: Gov. Douglas McKay, 168,814 votes; Sen. Wayne Morse, 150,857; Lamar Tootze, 94,299; State Rep. Mark O. Hatfield, 94,299; Robert Elliott, 92,312; State Sen. Howard Balton, 88,093; Gordon Orpuit, 88,093; William McAllister, 89,498; Johnson, 84,899; and Fowler, 84,841.

Next on the list were Scott with 80,000 and Mrs. Burns with 63,000.

Mrs. Burns was one of two candidates endorsed by the Oregon-Eisenhower Committee who did not win election. The other, H. Clay Myers Jr., who placed 10th with 37,014 votes.

Both Fowler and Johnson are members of Gen. Dwight Eisenhower and used his name in their campaign slogans.

Hunter Pots 'Em From His Wheel Chair

OKARK, Ala.—(AP)—A devoted hunter here who was paralyzed from the waist down 10 years ago in an automobile accident still manages to hunt every season by rolling his wheel chair through the woods.

Lester Matthews, 32, refused to give up his hunting when he lost the use of his legs. He also is a crack shot with a .22 caliber rifle and has won many prizes for expert shooting from his wheel chair.

He earns a living by operating a mobile shooting gallery which moves from town to town in Alabama.

Curtin School Contract Let

Norris M. Gaddis, Eugene architect has been awarded the contract for designing the new three classroom school at Curtin.

The school, with three classrooms, a kitchen and multi-purpose room will total 5,000 square feet. Gaddis said the building is designed to accommodate future expansion to six classrooms and a gymnasium.

The design features plastic dome skylights, with construction of exposed wood, rigid frames. Flooring will be of concrete slabs, conforming to the grade of the plot. Radiant heat will be employed.

Gaddis says construction has already been started and contractors hope to have work completed by the start of the new school year.

Look Evolved For Diaper Set

CLEVELAND, O.—(AP)—Jerome Goldurs, president of the American Diaper Institute and proprietor of a baby diaper service here, has the latest word in "unmentionables" for the youngest set.

"The hour-glass model (diaper) is the newest thing on babies," Goldurs reported. "When the baby grows, you just let it out a little—the diaper, I mean."

He explained that no folds are involved in the garment. "Instead there are pre-folds with eight thicknesses at the bottom and a graduation to light sides," he said.

The new diaper is also no challenge to fathers.

"You just lay the baby down," Goldurs said. "The hour-glass practically works itself. You pull it up a little and it enfolds the occupant. Then, too, snaps are replacing pins," he said.

Another development is new diapers in bright orange, green and yellow polka dots on white background. There are also pastel shades. No pants worn with these. The diaper itself is ornamental and serves as a proper garment for all occasions.

Posterior Slap Results in Suit

BALTIMORE — (AP) — A seven year old girl sued a dentist for \$3,000 Monday because the last time she visited him to have a tooth pulled out he "slapped her posterior with great force and violence."

The suit was filed by Patricia Ann Turner through her mother, Mrs. Isabelle Turner. The defendant is Dr. Morton Hollander.

The suit charged the dentist twice slapped the young plaintiff's face, then slapped her "posterior" after she got up from the chair.

As a result of the alleged trouble with Dr. Hollander, Patricia Ann has "been put in great fear of all dentists," the suit contended.

And formerly she "looked forward to visits to offices of dentists" the petition alleged.

Trash Burning Still Prohibited

Law in Effect May 15 to Oct. 1

Eugene Fire Marshal Lester Barker this week reminded residents that outdoor burning is now prohibited—except by special permit or in approved-type incinerators or fireplaces.

According to a city ordinance passed last year unrestricted burning cannot go on between May 15 and Oct. 1 of each year.

What's an approved-type incinerator?

ACCORDING TO the ordinance it is one with a permanently attached spark arrester made of half-inch mesh or smaller, a self-closing stoking door and a self-closing clean-out door at the bottom, and a metal grate at least ten inches above the bottom for good draft.

If it is of concrete, the walls must be at least 2 inches thick; if of brick, at least 4 inches. It can also be of pumice or concrete block of unspecified thickness.

OR, IF IT is of metal, it must have a double wall with at least 2 inches air space between walls. And don't put the back against the neighbors garage. The law states it must be at least 20 feet from a building or side property lines and at least 10 feet from alley or street lines.

Burning can be done in an outdoor fireplace—but Barker warns that it should be considered a barbecue pit, not a trash burner.
