

School Board Adds 2 Names To Monday's Election Ballot

In the speediest session since before budget time, the Eugene School Board received petitions for two candidates for director, set the date to call for bids on a new junior high dependent on an election next Monday and discussed the teacher situation.

Petitions, with more than enough names to qualify, were received for Lee Bishop and Mervin Vater, asking that the two men's names be placed on the ballot Monday.

Both are after the one school director post open on the board.

Bishop, station manager at KORE, was recently appointed to the board to fill the unexpired term of G. D. McLaren, who resigned; Vater, a local public accountant, is currently on the city budget committee.

The school board decided to call for bids on the proposed Cal Young Junior High immediately after the election Monday if the measure passes.

To finance the school, district voters will be asked to approve a \$600,000 bond issue, to be sold at the rate of \$200,000 a year for three years. The issue is intended to replace a \$200,000 a year serial levy which ends next year. In effect, the bond issue if approved would mean no appreciable increase in taxes.

The \$600,000, if sanctioned by the voters, would pay for the

junior high, a four to six-room start on a new River Road school, and a start on an Augusta St. school if enough funds remain.

VOTING WILL be from 3 to 9 p.m. (DST) at most of the district's elementary schools.

If the measure passes, any construction bids submitted will be opened on July 9, at 2 p.m. (DST).

Dr. Clarence Hines, superintendent, expressed the fear that competent teachers may be more difficult to find in the future.

EVEN THOUGH 11 teachers were hired by the board Monday, seven elementary positions and one high school post remain unfilled for next year.

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are needed at both Lincoln and Willakenzie schools, two primary posts are open at Harris, and a third grade job at Dunn is vacant, the board was told.

In addition, an English teacher is needed at Eugene High, Hines said. The high school job is expected to be filled soon, he believes.

"THE SITUATION isn't good for primary teachers with the qualifications we want," Hines told the board. "Fewer are going into teacher training and there are more students to teach each year."

In other business, the board considered buying extended coverage insurance at a cost of about \$6,000, but passed it up for the present because of the cost compared to the small amount of damage the schools suffered in recent years.

Hines read a letter to the board from Fire Marshal Lester Barker pointing out a need for additional fire stops in the new high school. The request has already been complied with by the architect, Hines told the board.

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Beer Prices May Go Up

WASHINGTON — (AP)—The government said Monday night some beer and ale retailers may be entitled to raise prices a penny a bottle or can under an order permitting them to recalculate their ceilings.

The Office of Price Stabilization (OPS) said the revised regulation is not expected to bring any general nationwide increase to consumers, although it may in some areas.

Agency officials told a reporter that retailers who did not raise their ceilings the full amount allowed when the original order was issued last January now may do so.

OPS said primarily the new regulation, to be put into effect by July 21, clarifies pricing techniques in the industry.

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
