

Roses, Rodeos on Oregon Agenda

(Special)—Roses and Rodeos are the two main events on Oregon's agenda for the month of June. The 1952 California State Fair, which is being held in Eugene, Ore., will feature a Junior Posse drill team, street parade and rodeo events. A Cowboy Stampede is to be held at Prairie City, June 20 and Phil Sheridan Days and Rodeo at Sheridan, June 20-22. The Sheridan event includes a children's parade, park program, grand Phil Sheridan Parade and the rodeo with \$1,200 in cash prizes.

The Douglas County Sheriff's Posse Rodeo, Roseburg, is scheduled for June 21-22 and Dayton's Sixth Annual Pioneer Buckaroo, June 28-29. Shows start at 1:30 p.m. at Dayton professionally stocked by Harley Tucker. Sisters will stage its Annual Rodeo and Buffalo Breakfast June 28 and 29, also.

Several stock shows dot the June calendar. They include the Oregon Jersey Classic, Portland, June 21, and All Arabian Horse Show, Pacific International Building, Portland, June 27-28.

Sporting events listed during June include the State Trapshooters Meet, Salem, June 12-13; June Race Meet, Ontario, June 14-15; Pendleton Open Golf Tournament, June 14-15; Dog Racing, daily except Sunday, Multnomah Stadium, Portland, June 16-Aug. 18; Junior Golf Championships, Alderwood Country Club, Portland, June 16-20; Oregon Golf Association Championships, Columbia-Edgewater Golf Club, Portland, June 23; Oregon Jaycee Junior Golf Tournament, Bend, June 23-24; Pacific Northwest Water Ski Championships near Sellwood Bridge, Portland, June 28-29; State Championship Car Racing, Ontario, June 29 and Oregon Professional Jr. Golf Meet, Tualatin, June 29.

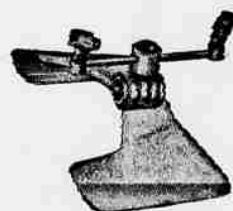
