

U. S. Reclamation Now 50 Years Old

WASHINGTON (AP) — Federal reclamation is now 50 years old. President Theodore Roosevelt signed the reclamation act of 1902 on June 17 that year.

That law is the basic authority under which the government has provided irrigation water for more than 6½ million acres of land and installed about 4½ million kilowatts of hydroelectric generating capacity.

Numerous Western communities with economies largely founded on reclamation programs are staging golden jubilee anniversary celebrations.

Commissioner of Reclamation Michael W. Straus, said in a Tuesday statement:

"Today may well be regarded as a gold letter day in American resource history, not only because it is the birthday of the Federal Reclamation Act but because of the golden opportunities that act has and will continue to provide for the development and the settlement and industrial and economic advancement of the western half of the nation."

"That program begun 50 years ago and pushed into full momentum during the last 20 years, encompasses some of the world's largest dams, reservoirs, pumping plants, irrigation canals and hydroelectric power generating facilities."

"But regardless of spectacular engineering achievements it remains basically an economic program. It is providing homes and livelihood for more than 125,000 families on farms which are producing more than a half billion dollars worth of crops annually."
