**Murray Reveals HST Promised Not to Use T-H**

**CIO Boss Denies Deal With Truman**  
GARY, Ind.—(AP)—CIO Steelworker Boss Philip Murray said Sunday that President Truman assured him last December "you need have no fear" of a Taft-Hartley injunction if the union would postpone its scheduled Jan. 1 strike.  
And he called Inland Steel President Clarence Randall a liar for saying that Murray and Truman had "made a deal."  
Murray addressed an audience of 7,500 at a steelworkers rally in this community of 130,000. About 27,000 persons in Gary and adjoining East Chicago earn their livelihood in the steel mills.

**STEELWORKERS** have been on strike three weeks, since the U. S. Supreme Court ruled government seizure of the industry illegal. President Truman has not started Taft-Hartley Law injunction proceedings to stop it. A pending resolution urged him to do so has passed one house of Congress.  
Before an overflow audience including steelworkers, politicians, mayors of the two hard-hit steel towns, and Lt. Gov. John Watkins of Indiana, the president of the Steelworkers Union:  
● Accused major steel producers of "a conspiracy" to prolong the steel strike.  
● Criticized Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower for voicing opinions on the steel strike when "he could hardly know the facts." Murray in particular objected to this remark he attributed to the candidate for the Republican presidential nomination, "Why don't they use the Taft-Hartley Law?"  
● **ATTACKED** the industry's reluctance to give the union's 650,000 striking members a union shop.  
● Said it would be "unjust to expect the steelworkers to undergo an 80-day strike injunction under the Taft-Hartley Law since they have already delayed the original strike 153 days on the request of the President."  
● Did not say what the union's position would be if the Taft-Hartley Law were invoked. But he remarked, "The Taft-Hartley Law does not manufacture steel."  
● Predicted the steelworkers will win the strike regardless of "what kind of suppressive weapon may be used against you."

**U.N. to Release 27,000 Koreans**

MUNSAN, Korea—(AP)—United Nations truce negotiators told the Communists Monday that 27,000 Korean civilians will be freed from U. N. prison camps starting next month. The Reds protested immediately, and violently.  
North Korean Gen. Nam Il accused the Allies of disposing of war prisoners "unilaterally." He said the Communists never have recognized U. N. reclassification of war prisoners.  
Maj. Gen. William K. Harrison said most of the prisoners to be released were swept into Allied internment camps early in the war and later were found to be South Korean civilians.  
He denied Red assertions that the Allies want to keep war prisoners as "cannon fodder."  
The truth is, Harrison said, "that we desire to return the maximum possible number to your side who evidence the slightest willingness to return to your control."  
The negotiators made no progress toward solving the last key problem barring a Korean armistice—exchange of prisoners.  
They did agree to meet again Tuesday at 11 a.m. (8 p.m. PST Monday).

**Rodeo Queen Picked**  
KLAMATH FALLS—(AP)—Marlanna Hellekson of Langell Valley has been selected queen of the Klamath Basin Rodeo which will be held here July 3-4. Miss Hellekson, 17, was selected from among eight candidates Saturday night.

**Brazil Police Still Seeking 96 Escapees**

SAO PAULO, Brazil — (AP)—State police reported Sunday all but 96 of nearly 300 escaped prisoners from Anchieta Island prison have been recaptured or given themselves up.  
The convicts killed 15 guards and civilian workers on the prison island Friday and escaped with stolen guns and boats. They terrorized several coastal towns and fought desperate gun battles with police trying to round them up.  
Sunday's announcement from the office for public security said order has been restored on the island and 323 prisoners have answered to a roll call. Before the revolt there were 453 on the island.  
The announcement listed 96 convicts as still missing. It said 30 had been recaptured, one killed and three injured.  
One of those captured was Samuel Freire, a notorious 22-year-old murderer known as the "Blond Devil" and a leader in bold prison break.

**GOP Delegates Request Ideas**

Oregon Republicans have been invited to tell Oregon's convention delegates how they feel about the party's 1952 platform. Mrs. James Mott and Mark Hatfield, both of Salem and both members of the convention platform committee, have asked for suggestions.  
"We have a responsibility to serve all of the Republicans in this state when we represent them on the platform committee in Chicago," they wrote.  
Persons with ideas about the platform have been invited to write Mrs. Mott at Rt. 8, Box 504, Salem; or Hatfield at 490 Waldo Ave., Salem, before July 1. After July 1 they may be reached at the Palmer House in Chicago.

**Newsman Claims Proof But—**

**Eisenhower Denies Truman Offer**

DENVER —(AP)—Gen. Dwight Eisenhower says President Truman never offered to help him win the 1952 Democratic presidential nomination and adds that he is not interested in any third party move this year.  
Last fall Arthur Krock of the New York Times reported that the President made such an offer, and Sunday night in a statement from Washington, Krock stood by his guns.  
The newsman stated he attributed to "a northern Democrat in an eminent public position" a report that in 1951 Truman told the general he stood ready again to help him become President. The source said the general had turned the matter aside, Krock stated.  
"THIS NORTHERN Democrat said that his informant was the President; he has given me the report in writing, with details; and, if and when he is willing, and not until—shall make it public," the newsman added.  
In his book, "Crusade in Europe," Eisenhower wrote that at Potsdam in 1945, the President told him he would support him for anything he wanted.  
In a swift Western swing during the week end, the general

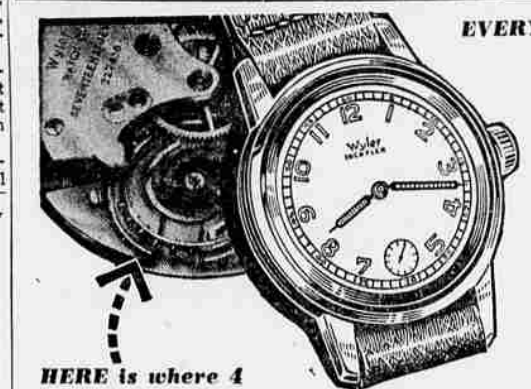
flatly denied at a Dallas news conference Sunday that Truman had offered to help him win the '52 Democratic nomination. Eisenhower also visited Las Vegas, Nev., and giant Hoover Dam.  
**HIS BACKERS** say that as a result of a five-hour Nevada sojourn Sunday, the general picked up three and possibly more delegates to the Republican national convention.  
The busy aspirant for the GOP presidential nomination arrived here by plane late Sunday night. He will make a telecast from 10 to 10:15 p.m. (EST) Monday night, taking issue with his rival, Sen. Robert A. Taft, on matters of foreign policy. The Denver talk will be televised nationally by the National Broadcasting Company.  
While saying he is not interested in any third party movement this year, Eisenhower de-

clined to commit himself on any future decision.  
In a fighting speech at Dallas Saturday night, he accused Taft forces of what he called a ruthless steal of Texas convention delegates. He called it a "great betrayal" of GOP principles, then urged fair play in the Chicago convention next week.
