Engine Valve Snaps Finger Holds Youth Three Hours

BELLINGHAM, Wash. (AP)—Duane Partlow's elderly auto-
mobile hit the end of Partlow's finger Tuesday and it took fire-
men, mechanics and doctors three hours to induce it to let go.
The 17-year-old amateur mechanic was working on the
engine of his 1937 model car in the back yard of his home during
the noon hour. A friend was turning the engine with a crank
while Partlow held his finger under a valve lifter.
Snap. The valve came down on the finger. Grease nor tears
could loose it and city firemen were called. They couldn't budge
the stubborn valve.
A physician was called and he administered sedatives to
the trapped youth as professional mechanics toiled without avail.
Then, with the youth sitting on the frame and his finger
still in the viselike bite, the automobile was towed to a repair
shop in downtown Bellingham.
There, three hours after the valve snapped down on the
finger, the motor's cam shaft was broken before Partlow could
be freed. Hospital officials said later he probably will lose the
end of his finger.

there are construction delays on

Ochoce Highway for 10 miles
west of Mitchell.
Columbia River Highway be-
tween Cascade Locks and Hood
River.
The Dalles-California Highway
from Modoc Point to Barclay
Springs, and south to Lapine.
Pacific Highway from Lane
County line to Anlauf, and from
Chenoweth Park to Oakland
Junction.
Pacific Highway west at St. Joe
Junction, with detour from Day-
ton Junction to McMinnville.
Oregon Coast Highway south of
Reedsport, and south of Coos Bay.
John Day-Burns Highway 20
miles north of Burns.
Umpqua Highway between
Reedsport and Scottsburg.
Coos Bay-Roseburg Highway
from Suicide Creek to junction
with Pacific Highway.
Wasco-Heppner Highway at
John Day River Bridge.
North Santiam Highway be-
tween Niagara and Detroit.

Elkton-Sutherlin Highway be-
tween Calapooya Creek and Suth-
erlin.
Tiller-Trail Highway for seven
miles.
The commission also said the
rim road around Crater Lake is
closed at Anderson Point, locat-
ed on the east side.
