

Uni-Hi Topples Mt. Angel, 24-0

MT. ANGEL—University opened its 1952 season, under new coach Chuck DeAutremont, here Friday night by rolling to a 24-0 triumph over Mt. Angel in an inter-district grid clash.

The Tigers struck for two touchdowns in each the second and fourth quarters and that sewed up the decision. Uni-Hi failed to convert any of the extra point attempts.

Halfback Larry Payne opened the Tiders' scoring for the night by plunging across, from two yards out, early in the second panel. A 15-yard pass, engineered by quarterback Keith Harris, and a 15-yard penalty set up this initial touch down.

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Payne, on another job over rickety tackle registered the third score. His final touchdown of the night was the offensive highlight of the contest. Payne, on a plunge right up the middle—and behind near perfect blocking which left only one Mt. Angel man on his feet—wheeled 56 yards to close out the Tiger tally action.

University, with a devastating ground game, completely dominated the action. The Uni-Hi club rolled up an impressive 311 yards from rushing, with Harris' timely passing accounting for an additional 50 yards.
