

# Inaugural Ball Ends Jubilee

## Eisenhower, Wife Attend

WASHINGTON 18—Happy Republicans wassailed on into the wee hours of Wednesday in a last great and gala jubilee marking the inauguration of President Eisenhower.

And Eisenhower and his lady celebrated right along with them. They didn't hold out until the final curtain at 3 a.m., but departed at 1:18 comparatively early in the evening. Long lines of limousines and taxis, stalled in traffic, were still bringing guests when he left.

The new President was in fine fettle, right up to the end. He still looked daisy-fresh, although his day had begun 18 hours earlier and had included the most impressive event any American can experience—being sworn in as President of the United States.

### DOUBLE AFFAIR

This was a double-jointed jubilee. At opposite ends of Washington two big, hull-chested halls had been given over to the celebration. One was the National Guard Armory, the other the McDonough Auditorium of Georgetown University.

Officially, it was a white-tie and bare-shoulders event, and most of the guests conformed. Tickets were \$12 apiece, and you had to know somebody who knew somebody to get them.

It was a brilliantly dressed throng. There were tiaras and long-lettees, fabulous jewels—or some very expert copies thereof—full flaring gowns with trains, and décolletage that defied gravity.

Orchid corsages were as common as dandelions on a summer lawn.

Well before the President's first appearance, most of the celebrities were on hand—Cabinet designers John Foster Dulles, Martin P. Durkin, George M. Humphrey, and

Wilson; Harold E. Stasson, named to be mutual security director.

Most of the senators and congressmen had taken boxes.

### TAFT SWAMPED

A long line of well-wishers waited patiently to shake hands and exchange a few words with Sen. Robert A. Taft of Ohio, Eisenhower's great rival for the Republican nomination. It was obvious last night that he had lost none of his popularity.

Movie personalities, some of whom had entertained on Monday night, moved around the room gapping at political celebrities pretty much as people usually gape at them. Few people sat still. They moved, endlessly, wheeling round and round the room.

At 10:45, the Marine band in

blue-and-scarlet crashed out the opening bars of "Hail to the Chief," the song that announces the arrival of all presidents.

Then, in an upper box, Eisenhower and Mamie and the members of their family filed in. A cheer went up. The President waved and made the V-gesture with his upraised arms. His wife smiled a little girl's smile.

Instantly, opera glasses and long-lettees blossomed all over the room, most of them trained on her dress.

### JOHN IN UNIFORM

It had been photographed before, but there were exclamations when the ladies actually saw it. It is "Renoir pink" and studded with 2,000 rhinestones. She had matching gloves and evening bag.

Son John—apparently the shyest member of the family—wore the dark blue dress uniform of an Army major.

After the Eisenhower's arrival, actor Adolphe Menjou, in the role of master-of-ceremonies, urged the guests to dance. Some of them tried. But by this time the crush was too great. It was hard to walk, let alone dance. A woman fainted.

And still the guests kept coming. Across town, an identical scene was taking place.

The President, who didn't get there until after midnight, stood, half leaning on the balcony rail, all the time he was there. He exchanged quick, animated remarks with Mrs. Eisenhower and other members of his party.

### WEST POINT CHOIR

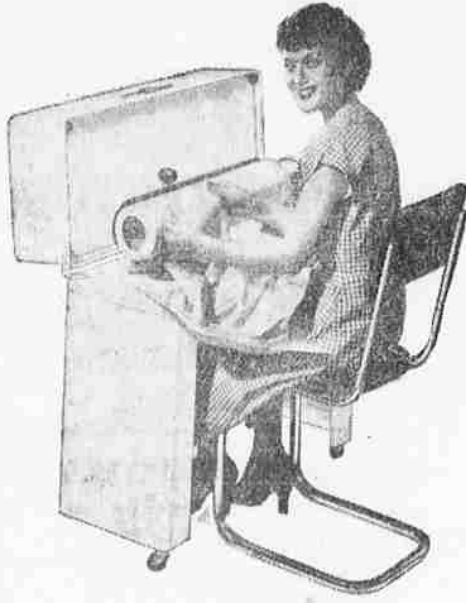
Eisenhower appeared ready to leave when another act was announced—and that brought him back to the rail instantly. It was the West Point Choir.

The cadets, in trim gray with red chevrons, marched on stage. First they sang their famous anthem, "The Corps." Then a spokesman announced that they would do a song written especially for the occasion, and for a highly renowned graduate of the academy.

Its title: "You'll Never Get Away."

One stanza ended with the line: "One short term won't do."

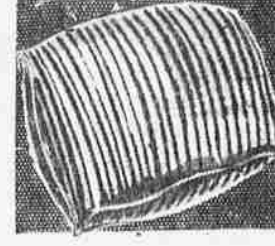

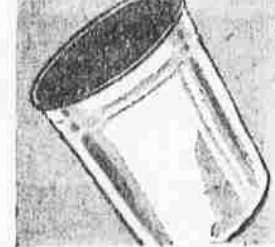
