# Germany Treaty Sought by U.S. Reds Report Tibetan Move

WASHINGTON (AP)—The United States is prepared to join Britain and France in offering security guarantees to Russia—provided these are part of a package solution of the problems of German unification and a German peace treaty.

The precise way in which the security assurance might be given is one of the subjects set for discussion among representatives of the three Western powers.

They are now meeting in Paris to prepare joint positions for the proposed four-power session in Berlin that would include Soviet Foreign Minister Molotov.

## BONNET CONFERS

French Ambassador Henri Bonnet conferred with Secretary of State Dulles and Assistant Secretary Livingston Merchant for about 45 minutes at the State Department Saturday on problems of the Paris and Berlin meetings.

Officials here said the Paris meeting is concerned not only with the security question—on which Prime Minister Winston Churchill spoke to the British Parliament Thursday—but also and much more importantly with the development of a set of proposals for German unity and peace which the Russians will be challenged to accept.

One informant said the United States government feels that the Western powers must have a "positive approach" to the Berlin meeting.

DATE INDEFINITE  
The West has proposed that the meeting begin Jan. 4. The Soviet government has not yet said whether that date is agreeable.

Churchill indicated to Parliament that he had some success in persuading President Eisenhower to accept his ideas about anti-aggression guarantees when they met at Bermuda early this month with French Premier Joseph Laniel.

Churchill referred to his May 11 speech, in which he suggested assurances he offered the Russians, and said he thought he had impressed the other Bermuda conferees with "the justice and advantage of such a course."

## POLICY UNCHANGED

Officials here said U. S. policy remains unchanged by the Bermuda meeting. They said it takes into account:

- Russia may have a real fear about a revival of German military power.
- Therefore, in connection with proposed steps for arming Germany in the Western camp Moscow could and probably should be given guarantees that this military strength would not be aggressively used against the Soviet Union.

Secretary of State Dulles outlined this policy to a new conference Oct. 6. At the same time he rejected any thought of a general treaty of non-aggression with Russia, saying the United Nations charter is in fact a non-aggression pact with the Soviet Union.

TOKYO (AP)—Red China Sunday announced formation of a five-county "Tibetan autonomous government" in northwest China "under the leadership of the Communist party of China and the Peoples Government of a higher level."

Peiping Radio, as monitored here, said the new government is in the Hainan region, of Chinghai Province, that most of the 100,000 inhabitants are herdsmen and 70 per cent are Tibetans. The rest include Hans, Mongolians, Kazakhs and Salas. The region is just south of Chinghai Lake. Peiping said a Tibetan was elected chairman of the new government, and that the delegates sent a pledge of loyalty to the China's No. 1 man, chairman Mao Tze-Tung.

## ON THE SCENT

The gas-caused explosion in Springfield's Memorial Building earlier this week may have sharpened the area's sense of smell.

## Scouts Erect Huge Building In New Jersey

The Boy Scouts of America national offices will move into a massive new home next summer. A new two-story office building and adjoining one-story warehouse are being erected on a 40-acre site in New Jersey near New Brunswick.

Since 1927 the BSA, national exponents of the "outdoor life," have been headquartered in bustling and cramped downtown New York.

Dr. Arthur A. Schuck, chief scout executive, said the new air conditioned national office will meet the need for additional space made necessary by the great growth of the organization and the need to bring together supply and administrative wings of the group.

The entire project, including land purchase and construction will cost about three million dollars. The plot fronts approximately 900 feet on U. S. Highway 1.

The BSA recorded an active membership of 3,183,266 boys and adult leaders last year, an increase of 41.3 per cent in the past four years for boy membership and 37 per cent for adult leaders.

The national council also owns a training school for professional leaders in the organization only a 45-minute drive from the new national building.

## Sun to Start North Again

A giant umbrella of clouds covered almost the entire country Monday as the sun's annual journey southward drew to an end.

The sun will reach its southernmost position—the winter solstice—at 7:32 p. m. (PST) Monday and start north again, signalling the official debut of winter.

As the new season approached, three distinct storm centers and numerous other weather disturbances began to dispel the mild, sunny weather many Americans enjoyed over the weekend.

The Weather Bureau reported that several fast moving low pressure systems had united early Monday to produce a "continuous cloud cover which covers all of the country, except the Southwest."

The forecast was for falling temperatures in the Midwest as the three cold fronts swept eastward. Temperatures on the Atlantic Seaboard were expected to rise, then drop tomorrow as the cold air advanced into that area.

One of the three storm centers slammed the British Columbia coast with winds of hurricane force, knocking out 600 telephones in North Vancouver and causing several power blackouts.

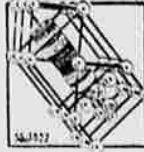
