Former POW Returns Home

KERMIT, Tex. (AP)—A soldier and the home town and family he once forsook for communism were quietly getting reacquainted Monday.

Cpl. Claude Batchelor, self-described former leader of 21 other American prisoners who chose to stay with the Reds in North Korea, got home Sunday.

He was welcomed by his family at El Paso, where he arrived by commercial airliner.

How the approximately 6,912 citizens of Kermit will ultimately receive him couldn't be determined right off.

The town was Sunday quiet when he drove the family car up to his parents' frame house that stands alone in its block.

This oil and cattle town on the west Texas plains is where Claude, now 23, grew up, where he played cornet in the high school band.

Kermit saw him leave as a youth of 16 to join the Army. Later it heard he'd turned "Pro." He set the town to talking again when, last New Year's Eve, he returned to the Allied side.

He seemed unworried after his homecoming. He said he was happy, hoped to get out of the Army soon, wanted his Japanese wife in the United States and planned to continue his education.

Batchelor said his enlistment has expired and he expects to be discharged quickly and "without a hitch." He has said he'd been told he probably would not be court-martialed for his activities in Communist prison camps.

Of his former relationship to communism, he said, "I've completely changed my mind about it."

'Round the World

Vatican Paper Says Cure For Pope Will Take Time

VATICAN CITY (AP)—The Vatican City newspaper Osservatore Romano said Monday, on the eve of Pope Pius XII's 78th birthday, that his "hoped-for cure will take quite a long time."

A one paragraph statement in the authoritative Vatican newspaper gave new warning of the seriousness of the Pope's condition as Roman Catholics prayed, for the third day, for his recovery.

"We learn that the general condition of the Supreme Pontiff is good," the newspaper said. "Owing to the nature of the sickness, however, his improvement is proceeding very slowly and it is still predicted, as his doctors state, that the hoped-for cure will take quite a long time."

The Pope's illness has been diagnosed officially as gastritis. But his physicians are waiting for him to gain sufficient strength so that he can undergo X-ray examination for the second time to determine whether his ailment may be more serious.

Monday's statement by Osservatore Romano is the first issued by the newspaper since last Tuesday, when it reported that the Pope's recovery had halted temporarily and that he faced a long convalescence.

Tuesday, when he enters his 78th year and marks the 15th anniversary of his election as Pontiff, will mark the 36th day the Pope has remained in bed. He is still mainly on a liquid diet.

Ski Train Derailed

TOULOUSE, France (AP)—A cog railway train streaking down a mountain in the French Pyrenees with holiday skiers jumped the tracks and plunged into a 1,500-foot ravine Sunday. Nine persons were killed and 14 injured.

The train was on its way from a ski run to Luchon when it derailed. It was believed the brakes failed.

As the train shot off the track and skidded over rocks to the ravine's brink, some passengers jumped. They were flung under the wheels and crushed between the rocks and the sides of the train.

The train was the three-rail type for steep grades. The rail's center track is notched to mesh with a cog wheel on the engine.

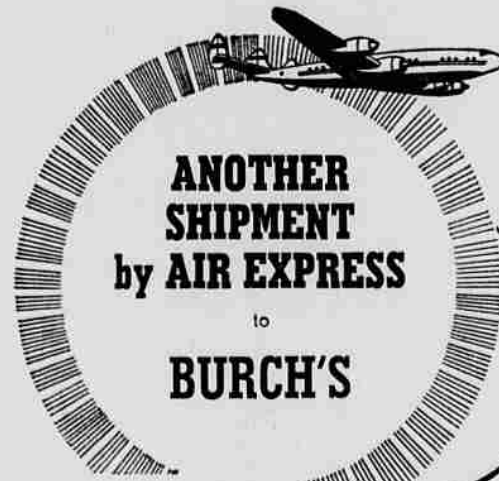
