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'Round the World Nixon Says U.S. Now Will 'Fight on Our Own Terms'

PHILADELPHIA (AP) — Vice President Nixon told a Philadelphia audience Tuesday night the United States has adjusted its thinking to the point "where we will now fight on our own terms."

Nixon, in the forum's keynote address, said U. S. armed strength and military planning is being rearranged "to carry out that policy," a plan which he said has already borne visible fruit.

"In not one area of the world," he said, "have the Reds gained this year—and in many areas we have made gains. For the first time in a generation we are experiencing peace and prosperity at the same time."

He said much of the credit for this successful shift can be traced to President Eisenhower as well as the National Security Council, Secretary of State John Foster Dulles and the "defense team" composed of Defense Secretary Charles E. Wilson, Army Secretary Robert T. Stevens and Navy Secretary Robert B. Anderson.

He said the United States must aid the Associated States in Indochina because a Red victory there would mean the eventual loss of all Asia to communism.

GM Makes Record \$10 Billion Sales

NEW YORK (AP)—Ten billion dollars in sales, more than \$14 billion in taxes, \$598 million in profits—that's the record of General Motors Corp. for 1953.

The sales of \$10,027,985,482 were the highest in history for any private corporation and eclipsed by a wide margin the \$7,549,154,419 in 1952, previous record for GM or any other firm.

Net income of \$598,110,478 was only the third highest for the giant auto manufacturer but GM kept its position as biggest money-maker in American industry, topping 1953 earnings of \$553 million by Standard Oil Co. (N.J.) and \$491 million for the Bell Telephone System.

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'Buzzie' Roosevelt's Wife Gets Divorce

JUAREZ, Mexico (AP) — Mrs. Robin E. Roosevelt, 25, divorced Curtis "Buzzie" Roosevelt, 23-year-old grandson of the late President, here Tuesday on grounds of incompatibility.

Judge Oscar Martinez granted the decree without asking for details.

Mrs. Roosevelt was present in court. Her husband was represented by a local attorney, who said the parties to the suit already had arranged a property settlement and had agreed that Mrs. Roosevelt should have custody of their two-year-old daughter.

Roosevelt is the son of Anna Roosevelt Dall Boettinger Halstead by her first husband, Curtis Dall. He has used the name "Roosevelt" since his mother's divorce from her second husband, John Boettinger.

Test 'Proves' No One Really Likes Coffee

PORTLAND (AP)—Nancy Morris, the Oregonian's food expert, made a pot of regular coffee. Then she made one pot containing a stretch of made of caramelized starch and phosphate and one containing two-thirds coffee and one third a cereal fig stretch.

H-Bomb Blast Reported Due In Marshalls

HONOLULU (AP) — A combat-designed hydrogen bomb may produce history's greatest man-made blast in the Marshall Islands late this month.

There are mounting indications that an H-bomb will be exploded between March 16 and 23.

Chairman Lewis L. Strauss of the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission is scheduled to visit the atomic proving grounds in the Pacific between those dates.

Two members of the Joint Congressional Atomic Energy Committee, Sen. Pastore (D-R.I.) and Rep. Holifield (D-Calif.) were here en route to the Marshalls.

Holifield said other committee members were due in a few days.

The first blast in the current series was March 1. The AEC announced that an atomic device had been detonated, indicating that the H-bomb was yet to come since hydrogen weapons normally are referred to as thermonuclear.

French Assembly Okays Peace Effort

PARIS (AP)—The French National Assembly gave Premier Joseph Laniel's government the green light Tuesday to negotiate as it sees fit for peace in Indochina. Laniel told the deputies the Geneva conference offers the best chance for a solution.

By a show of hands, deputies voted backing for Laniel and Foreign Minister Georges Bidault at the April 26 meeting in Switzerland of the Big 6 and Red China on Far Eastern affairs.

Earlier in the debate Laniel had told the Assembly he would welcome a cease-fire in Indochina before the Geneva meeting—as proposed by Indian Prime Minister Nehru. But the Premier outlined conditions so stiff that it was certain the Communist-led Vietminh rebels would not accept.

Before the vote, Laniel denied a charge by wartime Premier Edouard Daladier that France had agreed—in exchange for U. S. Military aid in Indochina—not to negotiate a peace without consulting the United States. He said no string were attached to the U. S. aid agreement.

French Air Attacks Hit Rebel Positions

HANOI, Indochina (AP)—French air attacks hit Vietminh rebel positions around Dien Bien Phu in northwest Indochina for the 90th straight day Wednesday and ground sorties probed out from the fortress town to make light contact with the enemy.

Only two rebels were killed in the offensive ground sorties from the important French-held fortress in the Thai country.

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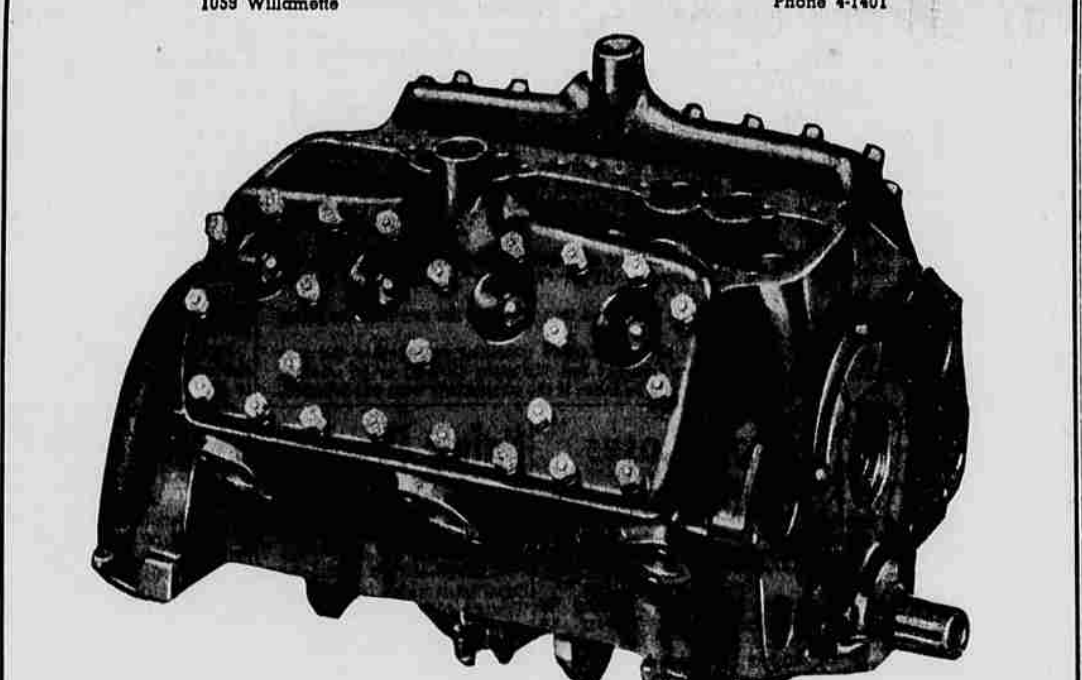
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
