

2000 Oregon Trail Scouts Get Ready for Big Show

Scouts and Cubs from the western Oregon counties which comprise the Oregon Trail Council will converge on McArthur next Friday and Saturday nights to present a two-hour Boy Scout show.

Months, boys from as far as Reedsport have been polishing their share of the big show. The show will be a display of the various activities of scouting. Up to 2,000 boys will take part in the performance.

The show will utilize the floor of McArthur Court, for a mass demonstration, unit demonstrations going on at the same time. A band, numerous sound effects and stage props will help make the show a spectacular.

The show will get underway at 7:30 p. m. in which 2,000 Cubs, Scouts, Explorers and Scouts will march on the American flag.

Scouts from Troop 96 of Veneta will present a demonstration of precision bike riding as an interlude while the other boys take their places for further acts.

The next act will be an exhibition of games played in scouting to be climaxed with a wall-scaling competition between Troops 3 and 54 of Eugene and Troop 15 of Junction City.

Next on the program will be a novelty extravaganza, "Noah's Ark," presented by Cub Scouts who will swarm out of Noah's Ark made up as real and imaginary animals, including such monsters as jinglefootuses and packatermites.

A history in miniature of progress in communications will be demonstrated, ranging from the ancient Athenian runner right up to use of walkie-talkie radios, African jungle drums, Indian smoke signals, bugles, town criers, pony express, telegraph, blinker lights, carrier pigeons, and signal flags are other methods of communication which will be demonstrated.

Cub Scouts will demonstrate their achievement program in a three-ring show, depicting the 12 achievements for Wolf, 12 for Bear, and 12 for Lions. Thirty-six dens will take part in this event.

"When Disaster Strikes" will be a fast-moving series of episodes showing scouting's part in civil defense and emergency work. Auto accidents, fire "hot wires" and a breach buoy will also show their part in the civil defense Skywatch program.

PIONEERING SKILLS
"Rope and Timber," a demonstration of pioneering skills, will see McArthur Court quickly filled with signal towers erected without nails, lean-to's, bridges, tents and ropes and camp equipment.

The Order of the Arrow Lodge, an honorary group, will present Indian dances in costume around an artificial camp fire, leading into the finale of the show: Camping in the Great Outdoors.

Special clown acts will be used to add humor to the show. All episodes of the show will be tied together with narration by Marvin Krenk. Horace Robinson, veteran director of pageants and plays, is in charge of the production.

Although the scouts have put in long hours of work on the big show, it will be produced without a single complete rehearsal. Thursday night, leaders of the various episodes will "walk through" their parts but the number of boys involved in the show prevents a complete rehearsal, the directors said.

This means those producing the show will rely upon detailed floor plans to be sure the boys are at the right spots at the right time. Handling some 2,000 boys in "quite a problem of logistics," Krenk conceded this weekend. He said an intercom system will be used between the main floor and the "staging areas" where the boys will assemble for the acts.

The Physical Education Bldg. adjacent to McArthur Court will be used to house the boys during the time their particular act is not on stage. There, movies will be shown and other entertainment will be offered to keep them occupied.

Scouts and cubs have been busy selling tickets, at 50 cents each, for their big show. A portion of the money will be used to pay the expenses of the circus and the rest will go to the troops who sell the tickets to help support their scouting activities. Tickets will also be available at the door.

The scout who sells the most tickets will win an all-expense air flight to Seattle, Wash., and any Scout who sells 10 or more tickets win a neckerchief slide.
