as quite close to the Communist party—perhaps even to some people as belonging to it. As I have said, some of its declared objectives seemed to be desirable. But I was never a member of the Communist party. I never accepted Communist dogma in theory; in fact, it never made sense to me. I had no clearly formulated political views. I hated tyranny and repression and every form of dictatorial control of thought."

The scientist, now director of the Institute for Advanced Study at Princeton, declared:

"I have reviewed two decades of my life. I have recalled instances where I acted unwisely. What I have hoped was, not that I could wholly avoid error, but that I might learn from it.

"What I have learned has, I think, made me more fit to serve my country."

In dispatches from Washington, the New York Times, the Herald Tribune and the Daily News said in today's editions that a special three-man board has been set up to hear charges against Oppenheimer, who during World War II directed the nation's first atomic bomb project at Los Alamos, N.M.

President Eisenhower and his top lieutenants went over the Oppenheimer case before the AEC probe was launched, the newspapers said. The charges against him reworded were sent to the White House by the FBI.
