Wrangling Marks

The Republicans "simply have to take responsibility," McClellan said.

Earlier Sen. Symington (D-Mo.) said he will call the subcommittee into a closed session Friday to sound out members on the possibility of agreeing on a single report on the charges aired in the public hearings, which opened eight weeks ago Thursday.

While Mundt held out some hope for an agreement, McCarthy told the subcommittee yesterday he thought there was "no doubt in anyone's mind about the fact that my three Democrat friends here will have a report—I could write that report for them... right now."

"I know what they are going to say," he declared. "I think they decided that before the hearing started."

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McCarthy said it should be recalled that Clifford and Symington were fellow Democrats, fellow Americans. Clifford gave advice to Republican Secretary of the Army Stevens that might not be expected to be "in a different vein" than a Republican might have given.

McCarthy was in the witness stand, from time to time, got questions bearing on the main issue of the hearings: The truth or falsity of the Army charges the senator and his aides exerted improper pressure for Pvt. Schine.

McCarthy, camp's charges the Army tried to use Schine as a "hostage" to stop the investigation of Communists in the Army.

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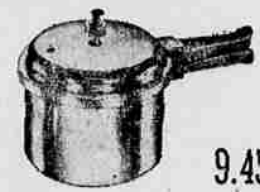


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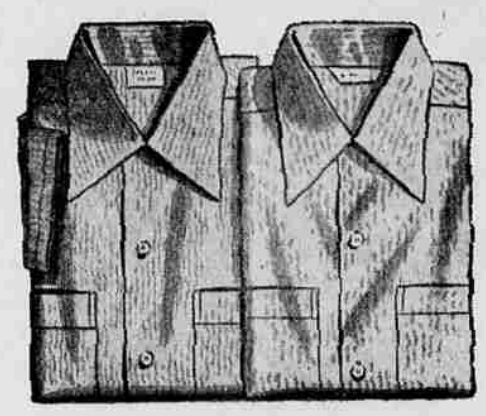
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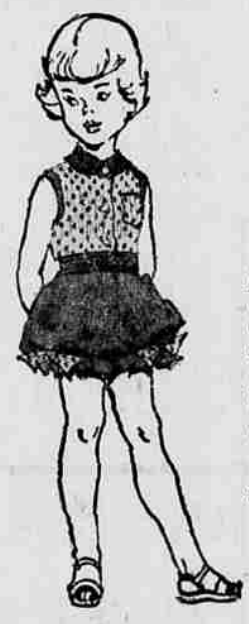
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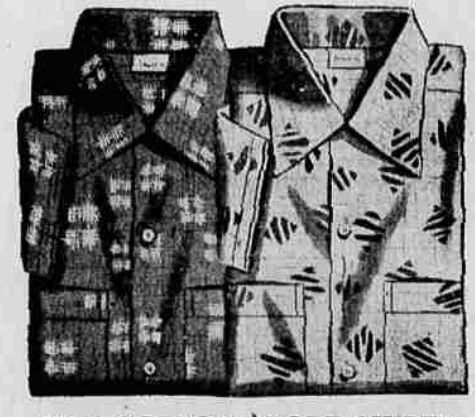
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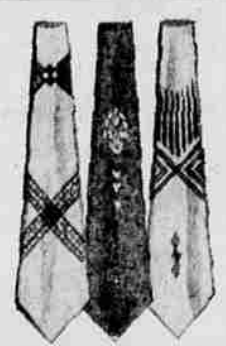
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
