

Plane Shooting Incident Still Full of Mystery

Very unusual things have in connection with the shooting down of a British passenger plane may result in betterment, rather than worsening, of Anglo-Chinese relations, enhancing British wishful-thinking that it may be possible for the two countries to do business.

The Reds still have to explain their attack on search planes, but may charge the Americans acted in unnecessary retaliation rather than self-defense, taking an entirely different attitude toward the British.

3. Nevertheless, two Red planes were shot down, a salutary notice that Westerners cannot always be considered sitting ducks.

Significant in the Chinese reply to the British note of protest are the reference to Peiping's desire to follow through on what it calls the easing of International tension achieved at Geneva; the humane expression of sympathy for the families of the dead, the offer to make reparations; the fact that the reply came so swiftly that it obviously was made without consultation with Moscow, and the admission that agents of communism can be wrong.

It is a reply which could be made by any civilized government. That is, it could if you accept the "explanation" of mistaking the passenger plane for a Chinese Nationalist warplane.

One cannot help but wonder if Peiping would have made this effort to appear reasonable and civilized if Chou Ea-Lai had been home from Geneva, or whether he will catch the devil for it from Molotov and pass it on to his associates when he does get back.

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Rockefeller flew secretly to Reno Monday for the first time since agreeing to a 5½-million-dollar divorce settlement with his wife last month. Bobo, a coal miner's daughter, reached the million-dollar bracket with the aid of two society marriages. She was not with young Winthrop when he met his father Tuesday.

She said: "One of the things I insisted upon in our divorce agreement was a period of introduction to his son. I'm afraid he wouldn't even know the child if this wasn't done."

"He has to know his own son." Under the agreement Bobo gets complete custody of the boy but Rockefeller, she said, will have at least eight visits with him while she sits out the re-

quired six weeks Nevada residence.

After the divorce Rockefeller will have visiting rights.

Bobo's residence will be fulfilled the first week in August, but she told newsmen she was in no hurry to file for divorce.

Actor John Carroll has filed a damage suit against a Dallas insurance executive, asking \$205,000 for injuries suffered in an altercation last April in the Shamrock Hotel at Houston.

The suit alleged that the Dallas man, Virgil K. (Bo) Howard, attacked Carroll while the latter dined in one of the Shamrock's fashionable dining rooms last April 8, striking the actor with his fist.

The resulting injuries, the suit claimed, have kept the 48-year-old Carroll from work in the entertainment field and also have kept him from operating his horse farm and private club.

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No other interpretation can be placed on Russia's revival of her all-European mutual defense idea, already firmly rejected at Berlin. China tries to confuse the issues in Asia, Russia in France.

Winnipeg—whose father hadn't seen him since 1950—swam and played with the 42-year-old oil tycoon Tuesday. Bobo termed it the first of "a period of introductory visits."

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Convict to Ask Supreme Court Execution Stay

SAN QUENTIN, Calif. — Author-convict Caryl Chessman's attorney prepared to fly to Washington Wednesday to persuade the U.S. Supreme Court to grant a last-minute stay of execution.

Atty. Berwyn A. Rice said he will file a petition for a writ of error with the Supreme Court clerk. The high court is now in recess. Then, he said, he hopes to get a stay from one of the justices.

Chessman spent Tuesday making funeral arrangements. The 33-year-old convict is scheduled to die in San Quentin Prison gas chamber at 10 a.m. Friday.

He gave explicit instructions to a representative of the Harry M. Williams Mortuary in nearby San Rafael, asking that his body be cremated and the ashes sent to Los Angeles for interment in a family niche.

"I want no fuss, no morbid curiosity seekers," he said. "You understand that all this is tentative. There's still a chance."

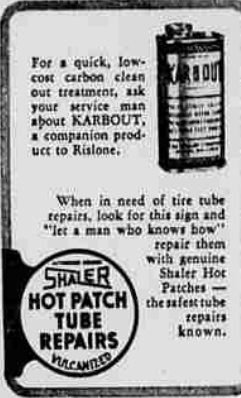
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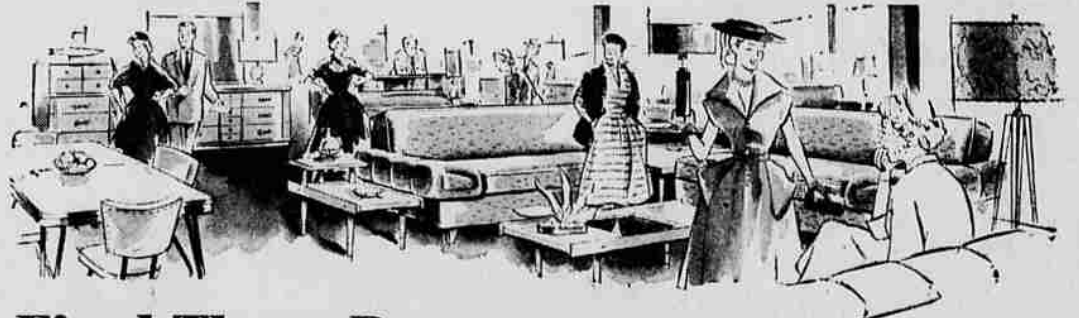
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
