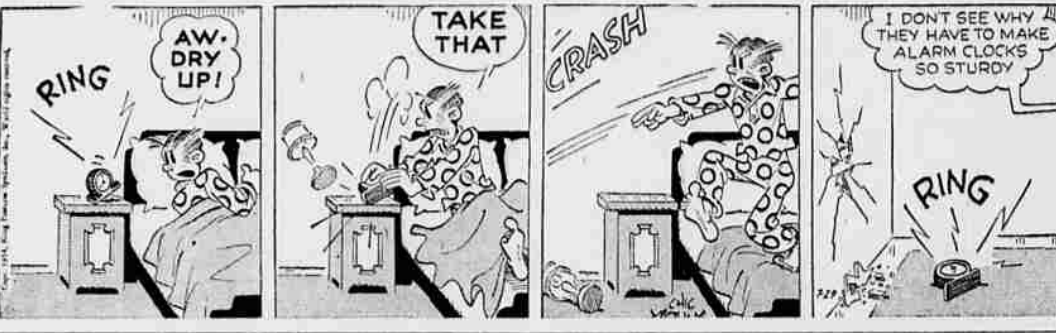
The Eugene City Council, still awaiting a settlement on the boundary issue in the Bethel District, met as scheduled Thursday morning.
