

Zoning Maps Now Available

A completely new map, outlining zoning categories for the city of Eugene, was made available last week at the Central Lane County Planning office in the Eugene city hall.

The new maps, in full color, are the product of many months of work. Howard Buford, central Lane planning consultant, supervised the project, and Al Lathrop, a draftsman in the office, laid out most of the actual patterns for the color process.

KEYED SECTIONS

The new maps cover all of the 14 zoning use categories now in effect inside Eugene. In addition, the map has some of the surrounding county classifications.

Various sections of the map are keyed so that additions may be made at any time, according to Buford. Most of the additions can be made through the same color use, since county and city classifications are about the same.

Keys to the differing uses are centered around three colors, plus black and white. The map uses yellow, blue and red.

MANY ADVANTAGES

Some of the categories are simply overlays of two colors, others are hash marks over colors and still other categories are described with colors and letters.

Buford explained that the new maps have "many advantages" over the old black and white ones. He added that the color is much more apparent than varied black and white marks. "Although the new map was much more work to produce, it is a lot easier to read," he commented.

The maps are for sale at \$1 each, including a complete copy of the city zoning regulations. The map alone sells for 75 cents.

Buford said the charges do not meet the actual cost of production but are necessary to defray some of the expenses in the project.

AF Teachers To Meet Here For Workshop

An Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps workshop for college instructors will open on the University of Oregon campus Monday. The workshop is designed to train instructors who will conduct a new program opening on college and university campuses this fall.

Under the direction of Capt. Matteo A. Salemi of the University, the six-day regional session is one of a series being held nationally to insure a common approach for the instructors in the program. Captain Salemi was at AFOTC headquarters in Montgomery, Ala., in June receiving indoctrination for the workshop.

The new AFOTC program is aimed at the fourth-year student. It is a leadership and management program and is a completely new approach to leadership in the Air Force.

The philosophy of the new program is to dispell the common idea of the "Prussian type officer." Objective of the new program is to have prospective officers obtain an understanding of the psychologies and needs of men and the importance of satisfying these needs.

Consultants for the workshop will be Dr. Ray Hawk, director of men's affairs, and Dr. Richard Littman, associate professor of psychology.

Stone Death Reported Here

Word was received in Eugene Saturday of the death in Santa Barbara, Calif., of Edward Stone, a resident here from 1920 until 1952.

Mr. Stone was born in Poland and was brought to this country as a child. His wife preceded him in death.

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Lane County Fair Plans Feature Big Poultry Show

One of the biggest and most interesting poultry shows scheduled for the entire northwest this year will be featured at the Lane County Fair Sept. 14-18, according to Buster Love, superintendent of the fair poultry division.

The show will feature fine poultry from several northwestern states, and in addition will offer special displays of ornamental birds, movies, egg displays, incubator hatching of baby chicks, and other attractions.

APA MEMBER

Love explained that Lane County is now a member of the American Poultry Assn., which makes it eligible to accept entries from anywhere in the world. Already entries have been received from Washington, Oregon, Idaho and California.

To prepare for the show, major remodeling is underway at the fairgrounds. The old poultry building is being enlarged to handle twice the number of entries, and to make room for a large exhibit of rare and unusual birds as well as the more common varieties. A coffee bar will be centrally located in the poultry area to serve free coffee to judges and exhibitors — a new idea which is being copied this summer by the Oregon State Fair.

SPACE FOR RENT
There will be display space for rent inside the building and along a new promenade that will wind from the poultry building around behind the auditorium building.

Of special interest to all fairgoers will be displays of rare pigeons, as well as 15 pens of peacocks and pheasants from the Pheasant Club of Portland. Judges for the show will be announced. In addition to the usual ribbons and awards, there will be special trophies and awards given by local individuals, clubs and firms.

fair in the poultry division will include a movie depicting the life of a chicken from the egg to the table, an egg display showing different grades of eggs, and a display of an incubator in operation. Baby chicks hatched in the incubator will be given away to children as they are hatched.

24-HOUR DUTY

An authority on poultry will demonstrate the dissecting of birds to determine diseases, and will give cause and treatment. Refrigerated, dressed meat birds will be shown to demonstrate the different grades—and there will

even be lessons in how to cut up birds for the table.

Caretakers will be on duty 24 hours a day to protect the displays, which will include a section for ornamental birds of all types.

Love pointed out that this is the first time Lane County has had a poultry show of this size and scope. There had been much demand for it from poultrymen all over the area, he said.

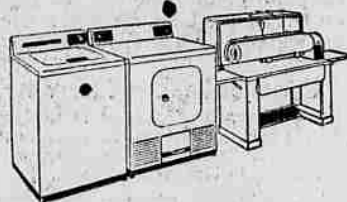
Taft Honored By Senators

WASHINGTON (AP)—Senate Republican Leader William F. Knowland paid public tribute Saturday to the late Sen. Robert A. Taft on the first anniversary of the Ohio Republican's death.

Knowland, who succeeded Taft as GOP floor leader, told the Senate "the ideals and objectives he stood for will continue in the Senate."

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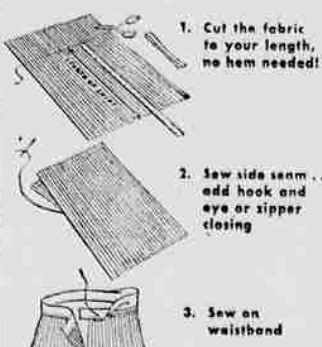
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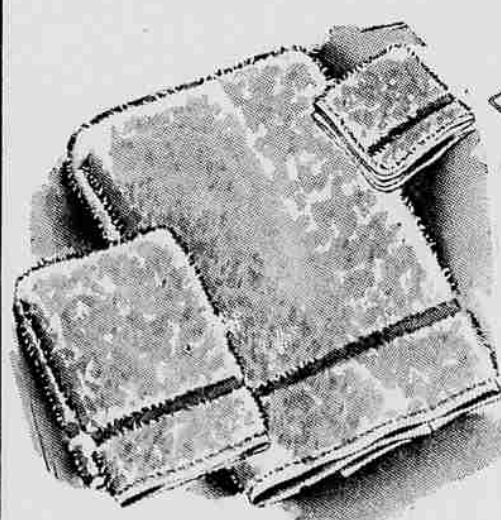
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
