

Police Learn Use of Grim Tools

Train in Gas, Riot Guns

Policemen can spend more of their lives in police work and need to use the grimmer tools of their trade. But they are not to be unprepared if they should come when they know how to operate the "riot gun" or the terrifying gas grenade.

One day last week, Eugene police met on the police range at Spencer's Butte for the first of a series of sessions in these little but extremely valuable tools.

The morning was spent in the "riot gun" which is an improved version of the old shot gun of story and legend. It is a short, 12-gauge, gun of great power and of police design. Guns of this type are now installed in all Eugene police cars.

The program is similar to the instituted by radio stations in Salem and KQAL in Astoria-Albany over the area's city-free Memorial Day and 4 weekends.

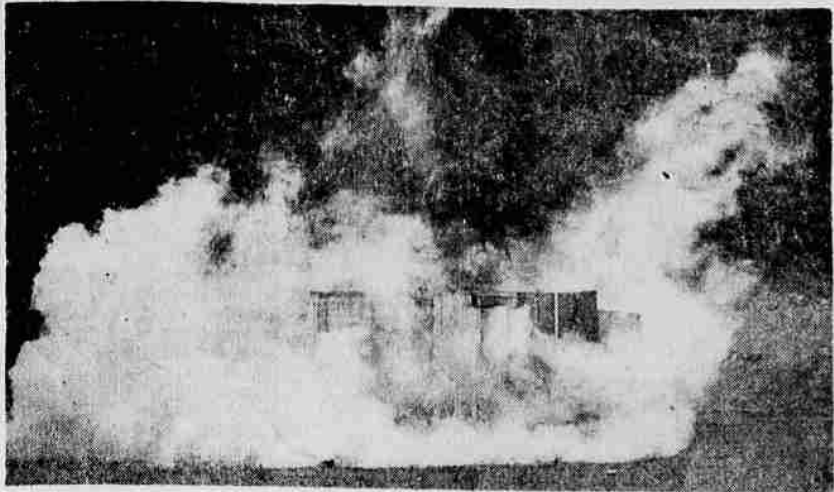

shots with the riot gun. Some fired more.

POTENT WEAPON

After the shotgun sessions the officers moved into gas training and heard tear gas described as a potent weapon for "smoking out" a person holed up in a building and an excellent weapon for breaking up a mob. Clarke demonstrated tossing the gas grenade and then the officers, many of whom learned something about grenades during the war, practiced hurling them through doors and windows of a mock-up "building" on the range.

They also learned to use the tear gas gun, a Buck Rogers looking weapon which fires a gas cartridge as far as 350 yards with good accuracy. The gas cartridges they used in training were outdated cartridges, no longer guaranteed to work properly. And a number of them were duds. This gave the officers a little rifle practice, as they took turns exploding the duds with rifle bullets. Outdated cartridges were used in practice to save money. However, cartridges of "live date" are available for serious use.

FORMAL TRAINING

After the formal training period a number of officers stayed around to engage in a little informal pistol competition with their service revolvers and their own ammunition.

Last week's sessions were the first formal training periods on the improved range which has been put into shape by the officers themselves, largely with money from their own benefit fund. Most of the money came from last year's Emerald Empire Roundup. Further improvements will be made if the policemen realize a profit from this year's three-day rodeo program Aug. 13 to 15.

The city bought fence material. The officers bought gravel, financed the grading and moved a small target house onto the range five miles south of the city.

NEW EQUIPMENT

The range has been used for more than a year by policemen who have been training there in pistol work. They fire at targets which are placed along a high dirt bank. However, the gravel, the fence and the target house are new this summer.

Police Chief Ted Brown said that a lock will soon be put on the fence to keep unauthorized persons out. While the range has been used during the past year as more or less a public facility, Brown said he feared city responsibility in case of accident, and also that officers feared vandalism.
