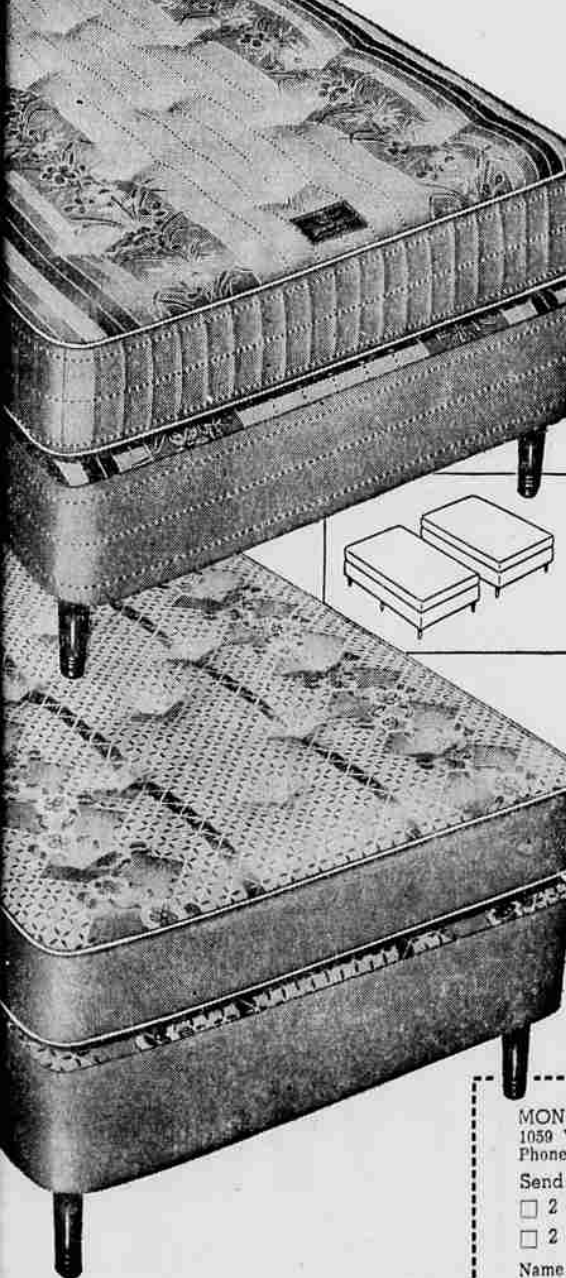

Greeks Defy British Laws

NICOSIA, Cyprus (AP—Thou-
sands of Cypriots, led by the
Archbishop of Cyprus and 100
other bearded Greek orthodox
priests, defied British colonial
anti-secession laws here Sunday in
a demonstration for returning this
island to Greek rule.

The crowd, chanting "enosis"
(reunion), arrived in trucks and
buses decorated with Greek flags
from villages throughout the
island. Colonial civil police pat-
rolled the area but did not in-
terfere. British troops were con-
fined to their barracks.

The demonstration here, which
centered at the Phaneromeni
Church, followed riots last week
in Athens and Salonika which left
67 persons injured.

Alky - Licensee Law Reviewed

Tavern Owners
May Run for Office

SALEM (AP—The owner of a
grocery store where beer is sold,
a tavern owner or any other li-
censee of the Oregon Liquor Con-
trol Commission may run for
office, Attorney General Robert
Y. Thornton said Monday.

But the licensee may not con-
tribute to political parties or can-
didates for office, partisan or
nonpartisan.

Thornton reviewed the limita-
tions and restrictions placed up-
on such licensees in an opinion
requested by State Rep. Monroe
Sweetland, Milwaukie Democrat.
In answer to Sweetland's ques-
tions, Thornton ruled:

"1. Nothing in the liquor con-
trol acts would prevent a licensee
of the Liquor Commission from
becoming a candidate for office.

"2. Licensees to the commis-
sion may not make any contribu-
tion to political parties or to
candidates for office, whether
such office be partisan or non-
partisan." He said that the at-
torney general's office had pre-
viously held that the law does not
permit a licensee to allow a
candidate for political office to
post political placards in any part
of the licensee's premises, or
circulate campaign material—not
even match folders—on the
premises.

Sweetland had pointed out that
the prohibition as to measures
was removed from the statutes in
1935. In this connection, Thor-
nton wrote "it is our belief and
opinion that measures are a
proper subject for licensee par-
ticipation."

"3. We further conclude that
there is no prohibition against
political discussion by licensees."

Thornton concluded that the
act "makes no distinction on the
basis of the type of license which
may be involved and that the
prohibitions apply equally to all.

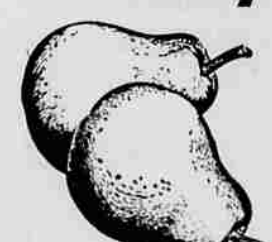
