

## Truce Pact Puts Planes Back in Air

WASHINGTON (AP)—American Airlines planes take to the air at midnight Tuesday for the first time in 25 days under a "truce" agreement between the company and its pilots, who struck over flying longer than eight hours at a stretch.

The announcement was made jointly Monday night by A. Dittusquale, labor relations director of American, and Clarence N. Sayen, president of the AFL Air Line Pilots Assn. Sayen termed the agreement a "truce," pending recommendations of arbitrator David L. Cole of Paterson, N. J.

Key to the walkout's end was agreement to submit the central issue—westbound transcontinental flights lasting more than eight hours—to a neutral arbitrator.

Cole's decision will not be binding, Sayen said the pilots would be free to strike again.

The announcement Monday night said the pilots had agreed to continue flying nonstop westbound cross-continent flights over eight hours without crew change while Cole studied the dispute.

## Postal Pay Veto Draws Criticism

WASHINGTON (AP)—President Eisenhower's veto of pay hikes for 1,750,000 federal workers evoked a flood of wrathful criticism Tuesday from labor leaders, employe spokesmen and some congressmen.

Many of those who blasted Mr. Eisenhower's action called for a new pay raise bill when the 84th Congress meets next January. Some of the critics urged that the veto be made an issue in the fall campaign for control of the next Congress.

The 5 per cent pay raise bill, sped through Congress in last week's adjournment rush, was killed by a presidential veto Monday, Mr. Eisenhower, in a statement from the Summer White House at Denver, said the measure did not correct "inequities" in federal pay scales and was not accompanied by a hike in government revenue.

**REPUBLICANS CRITICAL**  
Although Democratic cries of protest were heard immediately, some of the sharpest criticism was voiced by members of Mr. Eisenhower's own party.

Rep. H. R. Gross (R-Iowa) called Mr. Eisenhower's veto statement a "subterfuge." He said neither the President nor any other administration official advocated a revenue measure to provide money to pay an increase

to the classified civil servants. Gross also said the President and his administration did not "propose a tax measure to finance the foreign give-away program which will be one of the largest contributions to this year's deficit and debt."

Rep. Robert J. Corbett (R-Pa.), a House sponsor of the bill, said Mr. Eisenhower was "the victim of bad advice" in killing the pay raises. He predicted the next Congress would enact the legislation even if it has to override a presidential veto.

### MORSE FLAYS VETO

Sen. Wayne Morse (Ind-Ore), bitter critic of the Eisenhower administration, said the veto showed the President's "lack of understanding of the living problems of low income groups." He urged the election of a Democratic Congress in November "to override such vetoes."
