

Awards Mark Safety Record

Eighty-six men, representing both hourly and salaried employees from nine departments, were honored by Weyerhaeuser Timber Co. at a pulp division safety dinner at the Driftwood restaurant in Springfield Friday night.

Earlier this month these men—representing pulp mill, paper mill, recovery, wood yard, maintenance, electric, instrument, storeroom and special payroll departments—set a record of working five years without a lost-time accident.

Julson presented special plaques to two departments having accident-free records for five years. They were the electrical and instrument departments.

Art Welcher, electric foreman, accepted the plaque for his department. Instrument foreman Roy Potter received the plaque.

Special guest at the dinner was Byron Oyster, Tacoma, director of safety for Weyerhaeuser.

Five-year safety recognition pins were presented to each man by Julson.
