Bridges, Others Eulogize McCarran at Funeral Rites

RENO, Nev. (AP) — Sen. Styles Bridges (R-NH) told 3,000 persons Saturday that Sen. Pat McCarran "was the greatest American I have ever known" at a memorial service for the veteran Nevada Democrat who died of a heart attack Tuesday.

"Only great men with the characteristics of Pat McCarran can acquire enemies," Bridges said. "I admired Pat McCarran for many things—not the least of which was the enemies he made."

"Senator McCarran not only knew our government well but he had great faith in our kind of government," Bridges said.

Bridges was one of eleven senators and two congressmen who attended Catholic funeral services for McCarran at which 750 persons were present. A few hours later, memorial services were held at which Bridges and three other senators eulogized their late colleague.

'LIKE A FATHER'
Sen. Herman Welker (R-Ida), who said McCarran was like "a father to me," declared "no single man in American history has ever offered more constructive legislation for the benefit of the entire nation."

"America never produced a greater patriot... a greater statesman," said Sen. James Eastland (D-Miss.). "He never wore the collar of any political party... there is no man who can take his place in the Senate today."

McCarran, said Sen. Erle Clement (D-Ky.), "was a man of pas-

sionate conviction... he knew of no dictator to his conscience. He was one of the men who have shaped the times in which he lived."

Earlier Bishop Robert J. Dwyer of the Catholic Diocese of Reno celebrated a pontifical mass for the Nevada Democrat who died suddenly Tuesday night after 22 consecutive years in the senate.

YEARS OF SERVICE
"Our commonwealth and nation are poorer for his passing," the bishop said. "Through the long years of public service he labored hard and zealously for the things he valued and it is significant that time is demonstrating ever more emphatically how right he was on most of the issues of his political career."

Tenor Morton Downey, long-time friend of McCarran, sang "Panis Angelicus."

The body was moved from St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Cathedral to the State Building in downtown Reno where it lay in state until memorial services at 3:30 p.m.

Among the senators who attended the services were Senate Majority Leader William F. Knowland (R-Calif.), and President Pro Tem Styles Bridges (R-NH).

McCarran was buried in the family plot in Mountain View Cemetery.

Meanwhile, Democrats and Republicans girded for a court fight beginning Monday over the name of McCarran's successor.

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
