Hells Canyon Decision Due After Election

WASHINGTON — The Federal Power Commission legal staff's recommendation in the controversial Hells Canyon case will not be an issue in the fall political campaign.

FPC examiner William J. Costello ruled out this possibility this week in granting the request of staff counsel John C. Mason for a 30-day extension of the deadline for filing first briefs in the legal dispute over the Hells Canyon dam site in the Snake River.

The deadline was to have been Oct. 11 but Costello changed it to Nov. 10, eight days after the elections.

Declaring vacations and other FPC work had delayed the work of preparing the briefs, Mason had asked for more time to outline the staff's stand on whether the Idaho Power Co. should be permitted to construct three dams near the site proposed for a sin-

gle federal dam. While Mason did not mention politics, it was believed here members of the commission, who will make a final decision in the case, would prefer to have the staff position announced after the election and not before. The issue already is a hot one in the Pacific Northwest and while the commission and its staff may reach different conclusions, disclosure of the staff stand might add fuel to the dispute.
