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## ARC Finances In Good Shape

Departments Stay Within Budgets

All's well with the finances of the Lane County Chapter of the American Red Cross, a report released Tuesday shows.

The report lists all the activities of the local chapter and gives a statistical summary of the budget with amounts spent during September and since July 1.

Home Service activities have the largest six months' budget of the 17 items in the estimates. It has \$12,652.50 to spend between July and Dec. 31 this year. All of this money comes from funds contributed by Lane citizens during the drive last spring.

**RESERVE BALANCE**  
The Home service unit spent \$1,917.84 during September. So far, the unit has spent a total of \$5,506.91 since July. That leaves a balance of \$7,145.59 to spend between now and December, if the money is needed.

Other funds are the disaster reserve balances, still available in the entire budget amount. This money is budgeted in case emergency disaster relief is needed here or in some other part of the nation.

Only two activities are running in the red, for the first six months of the local chapter's budget.

Water Safety has spent a total of \$2,227.71 since July 1, which is \$727.71 more than the budgeted figure. This money, however, has been used for the Red Cross "learn to swim" program in the county, and expenses are always heavier during the late summer months.

**TO BE BALANCED**  
Officials explain that the deficit will be balanced out by another \$1,500 scheduled to be released for the water safety program after Jan. 1.

The other deficit is in the budget for Gray Lady services. Total budget for the entire six months, however, is only \$12.50 and the group has overspent by \$4.66.

Total six months budget for the chapter is \$27,030. Total spent during September is \$3,927.65, and so far this fiscal year, \$12,500.38. That leaves a balance of \$14,529.62.
