### Date Ice Box Cookies Delight To Jar Raider

Crisp ice box cookies, fresh and fragrant from the oven—is there anything better with a glass of cold milk? After-school treat for the kids, or before-bed snack for grownups, these "Date Ice Box Cookies" will tickle the cookie jar raiders. And it's easy, too, to keep a roll of dough on hand, slice off and bake a batch when you need them.

#### Date Ice Box Cookies

- 1 1/2 cups fresh California dates
- 1/2 cup walnuts
- 1 cup semi-sweet chocolate bits
- 1 cup shortening
- 3/4 cup brown sugar (packed)
- 2 eggs
- 1 tablespoon grated orange rind
- 2 tablespoons orange juice
- 2 3/4 cups sifted all-purpose flour
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon soda

Pit dates and put through food chopper, along with walnuts and chocolate bits, using coarse blade. Cream shortening and sugar together. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Blend in orange rind and juice. Sift flour with salt and soda. Blend into first mixture. Mix in dates, walnuts and chocolate. Shape into 2 rolls and wrap in waxed paper. Chill thoroughly. With sharp knife cut into thin slices and place on lightly greased baking sheet. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees F.) 10 to 12 minutes.

Makes about 50 cookies.

### Stuff Tomatoes

Looking for a new way to use up those last tomatoes on the vine? Why not stuff and bake them with large dry limas, American cheese and a little bacon and onion? 'Tis an easy, inexpensive entree.

#### Stuffed Baked Tomatoes

- 4 large tomatoes
- Salt
- Pepper
- 1 cup cooked large dry limas\*
- 1/2 cup shredded American cheese
- 4 sliced green onions
- 1/4 cup fine dry bread crumbs
- 4 slices crisp bacon

Cut tops off tomatoes and hollow out. Sprinkle with salt and pepper, and drain upside down. Mix cut out portion of tomatoes with limas, cheese, green onions, crumbs and 2 slices crumbled bacon. Fill tomatoes with lima mixture and set in custard cups or shallow baking dish. Crumble remaining bacon over tops. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees F.) about 20 to 25 minutes. Makes 4 servings. \*1/2 cup before cooking.
