WALTHERVILLE — Waltherville grange, represented by a flood control committee consisting of Douglas Zabriske, Mrs. Clea Zehner, Mrs. Guy Stephens, Elmer Bryant and Mrs. Tim Jones, adopted a resolution at the Grange meeting Tuesday evening. The resolution is to be sent to all of the subordinate granges in the flood control area of Lane County and to Pomona Grange. A copy will also be sent to the representatives and the senators at Washington, D.C.

The resolution reads as follows: "Resolution Waltherville Grange, No. 416, Waltherville, Oregon. Let this be known: In view of the change in Congress, there will also be a change of opinion in the policy of partnership participation of the Cougar Dam project, located on the South Fork of the McKenzie River.

The people of this district are well aware of the great need for flood control on the McKenzie River. We realize the South Fork is the logical place for the first flood control dam.

Time is of the essence in the construction of this dam since hundreds of acres of valuable land are lost each winter. Yearly loss is estimated by army engineers to be one and one-half million dollars.

Since completion of the Meridian Dam on the Willamette River, damage in some areas is much greater than before. Where the McKenzie merges with the Willamette, strong pressure is exerted on the farther bank, causing considerable erosion.

The Willamette is one of the most fertile valleys of the United States, highly productive of fruits, vegetables, and other products. Dairying and raising of beef are also important. We are not able to use nearly all of our land because of the heavy erosion when these flood waters wash over the cultivated areas.

The controversy between advocates of public or partnership power should not affect early appropriation, since power installations are not made until the dam is completed by which time power policy will be more definite. Therefore be it resolved, immediate appropriation for the construction of Cougar Dam is urged."

The resolution is signed by the flood control committee.

A meeting of interest to all who use irrigation for farming is scheduled for Tuesday, 8 p.m., Jan. 11, at the George Millican Memorial community hall to discuss problems pertaining to the water supply. Everyone who is interested is invited to attend. Representatives of the Eugene Water and Electric Board will be present for the discussion.

Wayne Endicott is heading the move among the farmers who live in all the neighborhoods served by EWEB.
