## Eugene Group Sends Happy Holiday Overseas

Holidays are happier on a full stomach. A Eugene Sunday School group worked on this premise to make the recently-past holidays happier for a family of six in Yugoslavia.

The local group, adult members of "Mom" Day's Sunday School of the First Christian Church in Eugene, assured the Yugoslav family of plenty to eat during the holidays by using the CARE method.

The formula is simple—donate \$10 and CARE does the rest. Some family, designated by name or not, in need of food in a foreign country receives a CARE package containing 14½ pounds of U.S. surplus food.

**EVERY TWO MONTHS** "Mom Day's" Sunday School group have been sending the packages all over the world about every two months since 1946. Their latest recipients were six members of a Yugoslav family with a monthly income of \$80, derived from the husband's earnings and government allowances for the children. Their diet is ordinarily a meager one.

The family, Nikola and Anastasia Onicin, and their children, daughters Nadezda, 15, and Jelitzka, 16, and sons Vladimir, 8, and Gradimir, 14, live in a two-room Belgrade apartment in a housing project. Gradimir is a tuberculosis patient. Since TB is a major problem in Yugoslavia, many of the 60,000 surplus-food packages distributed

by CARE in that country as holiday gifts went to TB patients and their families.

The Yugoslav distributions were part of 1½ million such CARE packages delivered in 31 countries in Europe, Asia and Latin America.

The packages contain flour, rice, dried milk, beans, butter and beef and gravy.

### PARCEL TO GREECE

The Sunday School class shipped off a parcel to Greece at the same time as the Yugoslav gift. About 60 adults and young married persons attend "Mom Day's" weekly Sunday School.

"Mom Day" actually has a personal interest in the CARE parcels. Two years ago the Sunday School teacher, who will be 83 years old in February, took a trip around the world. At that time she visited CARE distribution offices in major countries of the world to see how the organization works overseas.

### Store Entered

## Limit Removal to Be Asked

Removal of the 14-inch maximum length limit for trout caught on the McKenzie River will be requested of the Oregon State Game Commission at its annual meeting in Portland Friday.

The request will be made by a delegation of McKenzie River residents. A bus has been chartered by the McKenzie River Chamber of Commerce, which expects about 30 persons to make the trip, including representatives of the Guides Assn., the McKenzie River Protective and Development Assn., and other interested groups.

Other requests to be made by the game commission by the delegation will be that the opening date of fishing on the river be the same as on other streams and that the closing date be earlier.

Prohibition of fishing on the small tributaries to the McKenzie will also be asked, along with several changes regarding hatchery service and more planted fish.

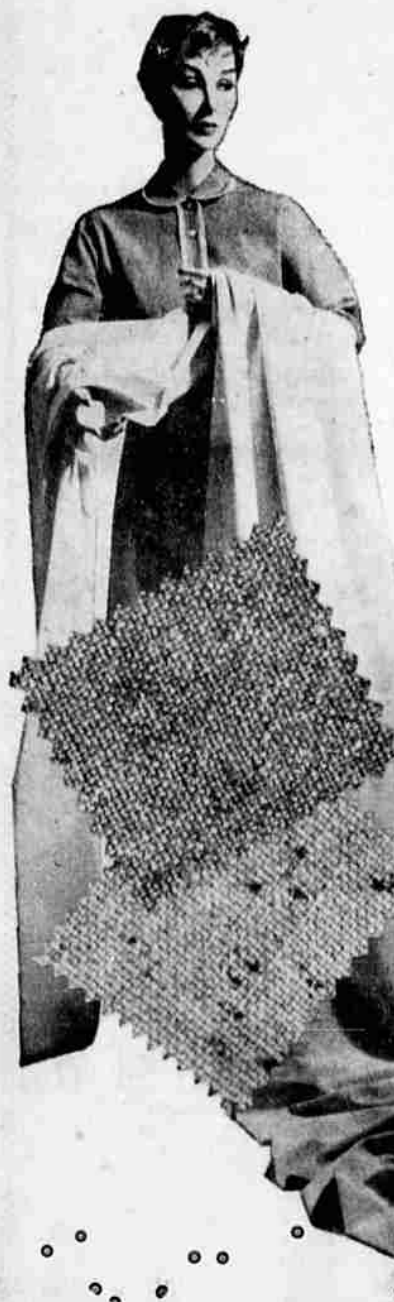
### Furnace Blast Spews Soot Over House
