Investment Firm Ordered To Adhere to SEC Rules

SAN FRANCISCO (AP)—The J. Henry Helsler & Co. investment counselling firm of Portland is under court order not to conduct its business along lines to which the security exchange commission objects.

Federal Judge Louis E. Goodman in issuing the interim order this week said this does not constitute any admission that the firm is guilty of charges previously made by the SEC.

He explained he had refused the SEC a temporary injunction because that would have involved a lengthy hearing now. Instead he set the trial for April 4. Meanwhile the interim order will prohibit the company from engaging in any practice in violation of the Federal Investment Securities Act.

The order stipulates that the company will not make any rep-

resentations that safety of principal is assured or that the accounts will appreciate 100 per cent in value or that the income of the accounts will be 9 or 15 per cent in any particular amount.

The order said that the company must not make representations to the effect that it has a special investment program for each client's account. It also specifies that the company will promptly deliver to each officer or agent engaged in soliciting or serving accounts of clients a copy of the court order. It further reserved to the SEC the right to ask the court for relief in the event of breach of any part of the court order.

The court also directed the company not to make any representation to clients that monthly checks are income, if they are not.

The Helsler company has 37 branch offices in California and Oregon.

Hopes Dim For Salvaging Historic Battleship Oregon

PORTLAND (AP)—The attempt to keep the old battleship Oregon from the hands of junk dealers apparently is hopeless, the chairman of the state's Battleship Oregon Commission said Wednesday.

Harry E. Williams, the chairman back from a conference with Navy officials in Washington, D. C., said Oregon has until Jan. 23 to apply for the old hulk, but the cost of towing it from Guam and restoring it as a memorial is excessive.

He said the officials told him the hulk no longer is afloat. Taken to Guam to serve as a barge, the old ship now is aground and partly buried in sand. The Navy does not even plan to go to the cost of refloating the barge and towing it out for an "honorable burial" at sea, he said.

He indicated the Navy would offer it for sale to scrap dealers.

Cadets to Use Plane

SALEM (AP)—Use of a C-45 airplane by an Air Force reserve training unit at Willamette University was announced Friday by Lt. Col. Norman W. Todd.

The plane will be stationed at the Salem naval air facility. It also will be used by air cadets at the University of Oregon and Oregon State College, Todd said.
