Dr. Soltman Here to Help In Wesley Methodist Drive

Dr. John Henry Soltman, Minister of Finance for the Board of National Missions of the Methodist Church, is in Eugene this week directing the Building Fund Crusade for the new Wesley Methodist Church.

Dr. Soltman makes his home in Auburn, Washington and has been a westerner since 1922. During his ministry Dr. Soltman has served churches in the Detroit, Mich., area, and has also served as a district superintendent. Since joining the staff of the Board of National Missions in 1947 he has conducted several hundred crusades in all parts of the United States and Alaska.

The local campaign is for \$50,000. If the goal is reached the congregation will begin construction on the first unit of their plant. While plans have not been announced formally, general specifications for the completed plant calls for a sanctuary seating 400, a church school wing to accommodate 300 to 350, and a hall seating 200 at tables. The local committee is chaired by A. Ray Martin, and consists of A. Ray Martin, Francis, Albert P. Bales, George W. Hunter, William F. Zinke, and the pastor, the Rev. Paul E. Peterson.
