Development Of West Side Meeting Topic

City Manager Robert Finlayson and other Eugene officials will attend a general meeting of the Westmoreland Improvement Assn. Tuesday night to explain proposed west side development projects.

The meeting will be in the auditorium of the Westmoreland School, 19th Ave. and City View St., starting at 8 p.m. The meeting is open to the public.

Primary topic at the meeting, according to representatives of the citizens group, will be developments planned at the Airport on Chambers St. Howard Buford, city-county planning consultant, and W. Riley Mataler, superintendent of parks and recreation, will explain the plans.

In addition, officials will talk about the proposed development of industrial sites in West Eugene.

George Owen and Larry Watson, councilmen from Ward 3, and Robert Hartman and C. Frank Shearer, councilmen from Ward 4, will attend the session.

Boundaries of the community association take in most of the area west of Chambers St. on both sides of 11th and 18th Ave., including the Prospect Park and Berkeley Park districts.

Oregon Historical Society and affiliated societies will hold a historical forum March 18 and 19 at the Mallory Hotel, Portland. Thomas Vaughan, director of the Oregon Historical Society, said this week that the meeting place had been changed from the Imperial Hotel because the dining room there has been closed.

Stewart Holbrook, Northwest author; Mrs. Martha Ferguson McKeown, biographer; Arthur Throckmorton, professor of history at Lewis and Clark College; and Willard Ireland, provincial librarian and archivist of Victoria, B. C., are among prominent speakers.

General discussion moderator at a panel Saturday afternoon, March 19, will be Prof. Marion Ross, architectural historian at the University of Oregon.

County Seeks Surveyor Notes

CORVALLIS — Lincoln County filed suit here Friday for recovery of old surveyors notes — or \$100,000.

The suit, brought by Dist. Atty. W. T. Hollen, names Mrs. Rose Hawley of Rt. 2, Philomath as possessing the notes covering Lincoln County land surveys. It says the notes were made in past years by surveyors Ord Castle, Alex McMillin, Harry Peel and James Derrick, and that Derrick took them and wrongfully held them from the county.

The suit does not say how Mrs. Hawley got them, but she said they were given her by her father.
