"Chief Crazy Horse," a CinemaScope story of the famous Sioux warrior, comes to the screen of the Heilig Wednesday along with a re-issue of "The Egg and I," popular comedy starring Claudette Colbert and Fred MacMurray.

Continuing at the McDonald is "The Country Girl," highly-praised drama starring Bing Crosby, Grace Kelly and William Holden. Following this feature will be a co-billing: "White Feather," another Indian epic, and "Hobson's Choice," a British comedy starring Charles Laughton.

Victor Mature and Susan Ball are the stars of "Chief Crazy Horse." As the warrior, Mature leads his tribe against white invaders of the Sioux territory and defeats them in some of the most famous battles in the history of American Indian wars.

Miss Ball returns to the screen after a year's absence to take the part of Crazy Horse's young bride. She launched a new career for Nurse Kay Biddle when she talked Director George Sherman into giving Miss Biddle a role in the film, too.

The film is Miss Ball's first assignment since her leg amputation in 1954. Miss Biddle was her nurse then and accompanied the actress on location to the Black Hills of South Dakota.

Continuing at the Heilig through Tuesday will be "Many Rivers to Cross," with Robert Taylor and Eleanor Powell, and "Apache War Smoke,"

Fungus Blamed On Mill Wastes

PORTLAND (AP)—The Oregon Sanitary Authority says that a fungus reported in the Columbia River recently is not detrimental to fish.

Fishermen had complained that the fungus made nets difficult to handle.

The sanitary authority said the fungus was not harmful to fish, and that it soon would disappear, since it grows only in a short period of winter. Ken Spies, a water pollution expert for the authority, said the fungus resulted from paper mill wastes dumped into the river.

State Census Board Sought by Johnson

SALEM (AP)—Rep. V. Edwin Johnson, mayor of Eugene, has introduced a bill to set up an Oregon State Board of Census to annually establish population of all incorporated cities in the state.

The figures would be used for allocation of liquor and gasoline tax revenues. Johnson said the bill would eliminate expensive censuses now taken by cities when they think they are entitled to larger shares.
