

Dulles Cites True Liberty

Negro Educators Hear Secretary

NEW YORK — Secretary of State John Foster Dulles says the United States may someday again find it necessary "to forego peace in order to assure the blessings of liberty."

"Indeed," he said in a speech Sunday night, "already many are sacrificing and risking much to protect liberty. We must therefore make sure that the liberty which we are prepared to defend at great cost is true liberty." He added:

'FEAR ONLY GOD'

"That means a liberty which uses and develops those gifts with which man was endowed by his Creator. . . .

"The freedom of which we talk does not mean the right to live selfishly. It means that men instead of having to fear other men need fear only God. It means the right freely to pattern one's life in accordance with the dictates of moral law. That is the law which enjoins upon us the golden rule."

'PRODUCT OF MANY'

"Peace is the product of many wills, and not merely of one alone. In the past it has been necessary to forego peace in order to assure the blessings of liberty. We dare not be blind to the fact that that may happen again."

The convocation, attended by 3,600, honored presidents of the 31 Negro colleges that are members of the united fund. It was held on the eve of a campaign to raise 1 1/2 million dollars, a sum estimated to cover about 10 per cent of the colleges' educational budgets.

Ousted President of Panama On Trial for Assassination Plot

PANAMA — Panama's National Assembly gathered Monday as a court of justice to try ousted President Jose Ramon Guizado on charges he plotted the assassination of his predecessor.

CONFESSION REPUDIATED

Despite acute tension aroused by the Jan. 2 machine-gunning of President Jose Antonio Remon, the country was reported quiet.

A young lawyer, Ruben Miro, confessed that he shot down Remon at the Juan Franco race track. He charged that Guizado plotted with him. Later, in letters from his cell, he repudiated the confession.

Guizado, a wealthy 56-year-old civil engineer and contractor who had been Remon's first vice president, became president Jan. 3. After Miro's arrest, he was detained Jan. 15 and the National Assembly impeached him a few hours later. Second Vice President Ricardo Arias Espinosa took over the presidency.

Lane Chapter Second Largest

Funds Increased For Forest Service

WASHINGTON — An increase of \$1,083,000 in the budget requests for funds for the Department of Agriculture forest service was approved by the House Appropriations Committee Monday.

The increase for state and private forest cooperation, brought the recommended appropriation for the year beginning July 1 for that purpose to \$10,683,090, the same as for this year. President Eisenhower's budget had requested \$9,600,000.

Guizado's attorney Felipe Juan Escobar countered "there is not enough evidence even to indict." He termed the proceedings "un-constitutional and prompted by political motives."

Remon had been a power behind the scenes for more than a decade, serving as chief of the national police, prior to his election as president in May, 1952.

10-YEAR MAXIMUM

Guizado, who denied the charges, faces a maximum penalty of 10 years in prison if convicted. Votes of 36 of the 53 Assembly members are required for conviction.

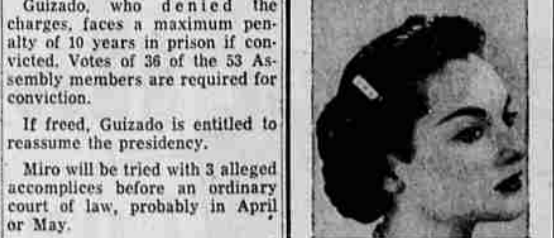
If freed, Guizado is entitled to resume the presidency.

Miro will be tried with 3 alleged accomplices before an ordinary court of law, probably in April or May.

Guizado's attorneys have moved for postponement of his trial, contending they have not had enough time to gather evidence. The commission on proceedings established by the Assembly for the hearing was reported ready to ask for denial of the request Monday.

In advance of the Assembly hearing, prosecutor Jose N. Lasso de la Vega said he has "real, substantial" evidence against Guizado. He charged the killing of Re-

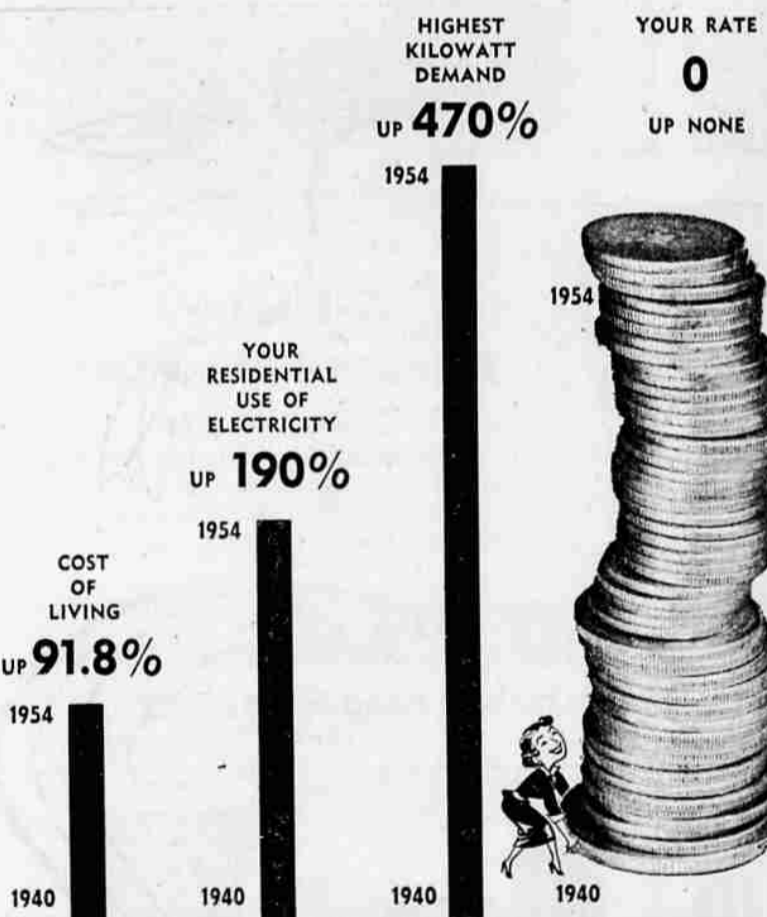

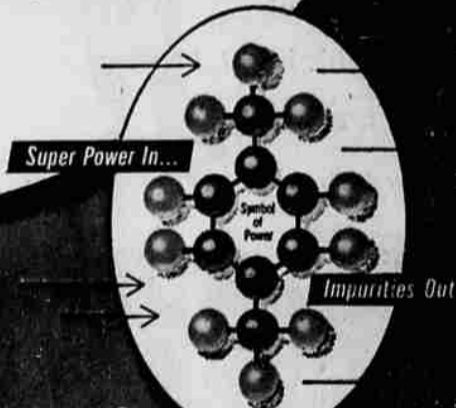
