She said she was referring to the councilman L. B. Bartlett, whose employment was abruptly terminated after he had resigned with a month's notice; to former Police Chief Harry Howard and former Police Captain M. J. Redfearn, whose resignations were requested and accepted; and to City Recorder William Mansell, who was asked to resign by Hamilton, but refused.

APPOINTMENTS DUE

"Now the air has been cleared," she said, "we can get on with good, progressive government for the people of Springfield."

It will fall to the four remaining councilmen to appoint replacements to fill out the terms of office of Nicholas and Breedlove. The council's next scheduled meeting is May 23. It was not immediately determined whether a special meeting will be called before that date to act upon new council appointments. Mayor Edward C. Harny Jr. said it is important to fill the vacant posts shortly so consideration of the coming year's budget can get underway. But at the same time, he said, the council will want to give a good deal of consideration to the appointments.

'EXTREMELY PROUD'

"We want to get people on there who will best serve the interests of the people of Springfield," he said.

Harny termed the results of the election "a direct mandate from the people."

He said he is "extremely proud" of the voters of Springfield and the way they got "to the basic issues involved."

A big margin in favor of recall was stacked up at all 13 of the city's polling places. Breedlove's home precinct—Number 9—voted 88 to 34 in favor of his recall. Voters in the three precincts of the Paramount area—Numbers 7, 8 and 16—where Nicholas lives, voted 185 to 94 for his recall.

He collapsed during a vigorous May Day speech at Trieste. Doctors said he suffered blood congestion, caused by sunstroke. He has not been able to rise from bed since.

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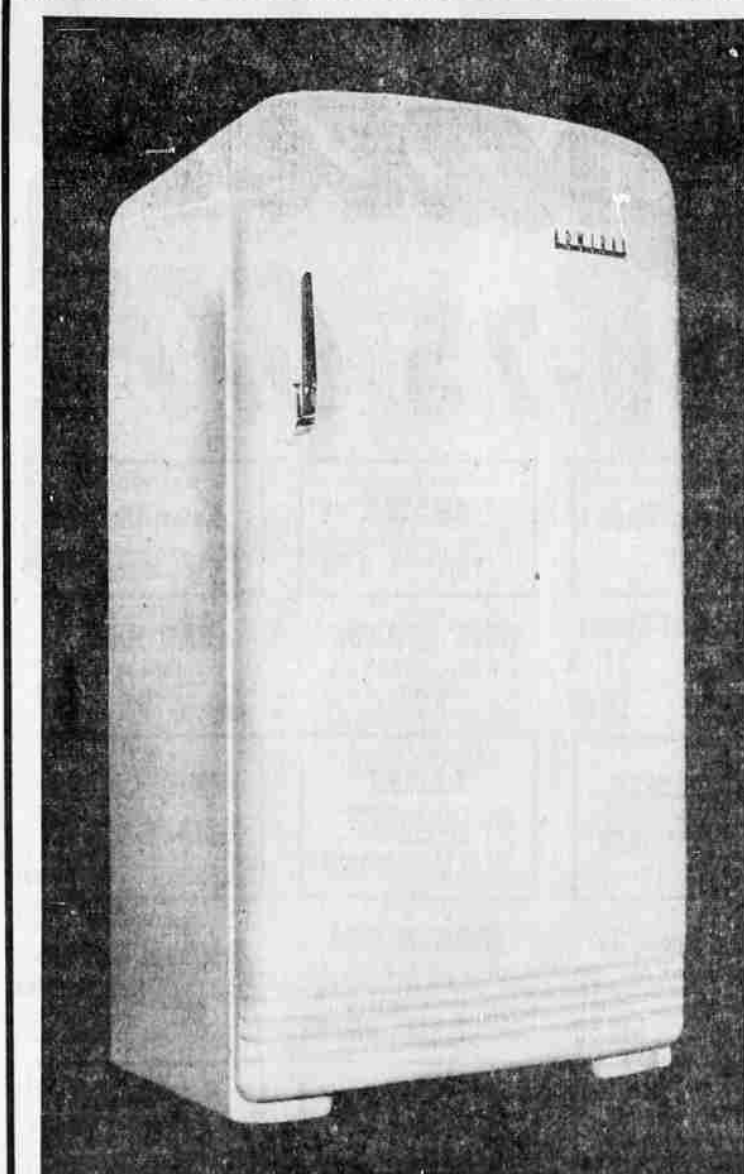
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
