County Fair Winners May Enter Contest

Winners in crochet classes of the textile division at the 1955 Lane County Fair will again be eligible to compete for prizes in the national crochet contest. Mrs. Mary Aye, division superintendent, announced this week. Prizes in the national contest will total \$3,000, and trips to New York for the champions.

In addition, Smart Crochet magazine is offering another \$800 in prizes for crocheted pieces featuring original design. All pieces submitted for this contest should be marked "original design."

The finals in the 1955 national crochet contest will be in New York, and open to any crocheter awarded the special contest blue ribbon at Lane County Fair. National awards will include \$500 for the grand national champion, and \$100 each to teen-age and men's champions. All three will win a trip to New York. There will be hundreds of other cash prizes.

Entries must be made of mercerized cotton thread in any size up to and including 100. Mercerized cotton with metallic strand is also acceptable.

All entries must be completed since Jan. 1, 1955, though they may have been started earlier. Any number of articles may be entered.
