OSC Sponsor Of Conference On Teaching

A conference on "Superior Teaching" aimed at continued improvement of college teaching in Oregon, will be sponsored next Friday and Saturday by Oregon State College with all of the state's public and private colleges and universities participating. Earl J. McGrath, formerly U.S. commissioner of education and now executive officer of the Institute of Higher Education at Columbia University, will be keynote speaker. Program participants from the University of Oregon include: L. S. Cressman, head of the department of anthropology; Glenn Starlin, head of the department of speech, and J. E. Lallas, assistant professor of education. Another speaker will be William H. Burton, professor emeritus of education at Harvard University, who now lives in Corvallis. Topics to be discussed at the conference will include: aims of education, better selection, organization and use of subject matter, improvement of classroom procedures, evaluation of teaching results, teaching through television and future adjustments in college teaching. In charge of arrangements is the OSC Committee of Advancement of Teaching, with C. L. Anderson, professor of hygiene and health education, as chairman. Present plans of the committee call for the conference to become an annual affair at Oregon State College.
