Road Dispute To Be Aired

LA GRANDE—The controversy over the proposed 31-mile road into the primitive Minam River country will get an airing here next Tuesday. The Forest Service will hold a public hearing on its proposal to open 80,000 acres in the Eagle Cap Wilderness Area to logging. A number of sportsmen's organizations oppose it. Supervisor John B. Smith of the Walla-Walla National Forest said the road would be beneficial to sportsmen, providing easier access to an area that has 10,000 mule deer, 3,000 elk and 500 black bear. The sportsmen's organizations want it preserved as a wilderness area, to be penetrated only on foot or on horse. Smith said the area has 450 million board feet of timber. He said it could be harvested at the rate of 4 1/2 million feet a year and could provide \$1 million income annually for the area. Smith said more hunters should kill animals there to prevent starvation of the game. Among organizations opposing the proposal are the Union County chapter of the Izaak Walton League and the Powder River Sportsmen's Club of Baker. They said William O. Douglas, U. S. Supreme Court justice, has authorized the last chapter in his book, "My Wilderness," to be read into the record. Douglas, who has visited the area a number of times, opposes the road.

Funeral services were held Saturday for Lane M. Smith, 55, 2714 Manor Dr., Springfield, a life-long Lane County resident, who died Wednesday. Services were in Buell Chapel with the Rev. Orvan Johnson officiating. Interment was in the Greenwood Cemetery. Mr. Smith was born May 19, 1905, at Fall Creek. He was married to Mary Godard on March 19, 1928, in Cottage Grove. Mr. Smith is survived by his widow; one son, Jerry Smith, of Springfield; and three grandchildren.

Crater Lake Road To Open May 23

SALEM (UPI)—The Crater Lake North and West Diamond Lake Highways will open to through traffic May 23 at 2 p.m. The Oregon Highway Department reports. The department said, however, a protective load limit will be in effect on the two routes to allow drainage and drying of the road beds. The limit will permit 11,000 pound gross weight maximum for single axles and 20,000 pound for tandem axles. The department said the same load limit will be in effect on the East Diamond Lake Highway.

WASHINGTON (Special)—The Federal Communications Commission has renewed the broadcast license of radio station KEED, Springfield. An FCC official advised the office of Sen. Maurine Neuberger (D-Ore) that the new license runs for 16 months. KEED was one of a number of stations whose license renewal applications were held up last year. The FCC never explained why it held up the KEED application.
