Cummings Not Mourning Comedy Flop

NEW YORK (AP) — Actors are a resilient group. They start each new project with high hopes and brave words, but if the show flops prematurely, or if they are clobbered by the critics, they pick themselves up, dust themselves off — and get on to the next.

Victim of one of the season's croppers is Robert Cummings, whose comedy series on CBS went off the air earlier this month without even finishing a full season. Is Cummings downhearted?

"No," said the veteran film and television actor. "We knew, by about the 15th show, that we had too much — that it was too expensive to do a full adventure show in a half hour — and with airplanes."
