

Dutch Bolster Island Forces

THE HAGUE, Netherlands (A)—Dutch warships and troops rushed toward West New Guinea Wednesday to counter stepped-up Indonesian infiltration of the disputed territory.

The Dutch government dispatched four warships and airborne troops after receiving word of increased military activity in the area following a breakdown in U.S.-sponsored negotiations between the Hague and Jakarta.

The Dutch began airlifting an estimated 1,200 troops to New Guinea in DC8 airliners chartered from KLM, the Dutch airline. A planeload of 138 marines left Amsterdam Tuesday, and airport circles said one of KLM's two daily flights to New York had been cancelled for the next nine days to accommodate the airlift.

Presbyterian Prelate Calls On Pope John

VATICAN CITY (A)—Pope John XXIII received the Rt. Rev. Archibald Campbell Craig, moderator of the Church of Scotland's general assembly, in a courtesy visit Wednesday.

Their meeting was the first between a supreme ruler of the Roman Catholic Church and a head of the Church of Scotland, which is considered the "mother church" of Presbyterianism in English-speaking countries. In Scotland it is recognized as the established state church, although self-supporting.

The meeting was the third by Protestant church leaders with Pope John within the past 15 months.

The series was started on Dec. 2, 1959, by the Rev. Geoffrey Fisher, then archbishop of Canterbury and primate of the Church of England. It was followed last year by a similar visit to the Pope by Bishop Arthur Lichtenberger, head of the Protestant Episcopal Church of the United States.

Pope John and Dr. Craig talked for 35 minutes in a visit that the Vatican press office described as very cordial. No details were given.

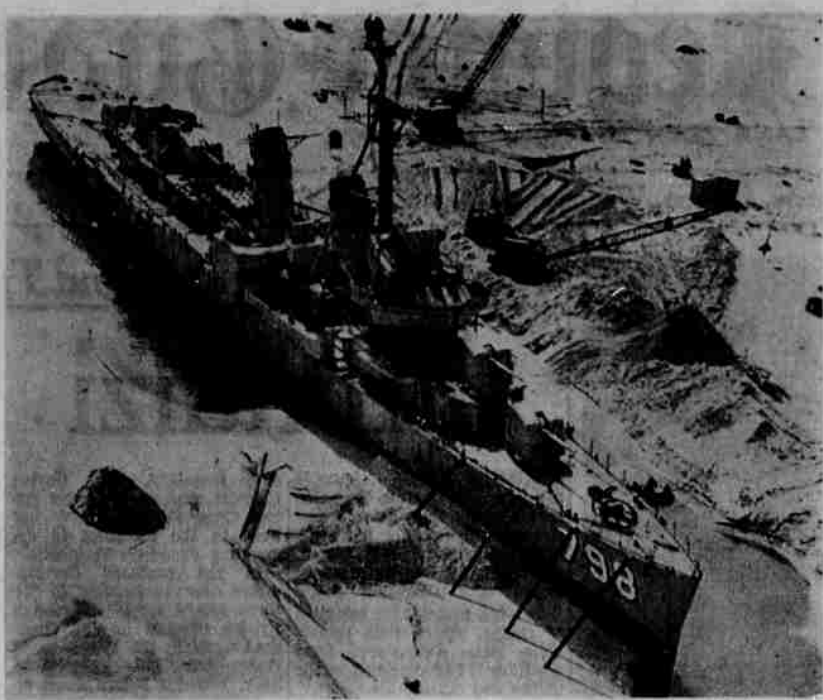
Constitution Group To Meet in Capitol

Hausner Asks Death Penalty

JERUSALEM — Atty. Gen. Gideon Hausner concluded his case against Adolf Eichmann's appeal for clemency Wednesday with a plea to Israel's highest court to uphold the death sentence.

Hausner, winding up a 13-hour attack on Eichmann's arguments against the death penalty, declared:

"He who chooses to follow the ways of Adolf Eichmann—the ways of hatred and murder—must have as his end shame and his punishment death. There can be no justice here unless this is Eichmann's punishment. 'I ask that this court reject his appeal against his sentence.' Hausner said Eichmann deserved Biblical execution — by stoning, burning, strangling, and the sword—for every baby he consigned to the gas chamber. Eichmann never flinched as he listened to Hausner ask for his execution for the second time. A special tribunal last December accepted Hausner's arguments and condemned the former Gestapo colonel to die. Unless the Supreme Court

grants a defense motion to put Eichmann, 56, on the stand again, the state of Israel has had its last say in court in the massive case it brought against

Hughes to Run As Independent

BOSTON (A)—H. Stuart Hughes, a Harvard historian and a grandson of the late Supreme Court Justice Charles Evans Hughes, announced Tuesday his candidacy—as an independent—for the U.S. Senate from Massachusetts.

Although a Democrat, Hughes said he preferred not to get into the party battle for the Senate nomination in which Edward M. Kennedy, brother of the President, opposes State Atty. Gen. Edward J. McCormack Jr. McCormack is the nephew of U.S. House Speaker John W. McCormack.

To win a place on the fall ballot, Hughes must file some 72,000 signatures on nomination papers.

him as the central figure in the Nazi extermination of six million European Jews.

Immediately after Hausner concluded his plea, the five justices adjourned until Thursday. Eichmann's counsel, Robert Servatius, will then make a final statement seeking commutation of the death sentence. The court also is likely to rule Thursday on defense motions to introduce new witnesses to hear the accused again.

The court will probably take about a month to write its verdict on the appeal.

Department to Test Warning Buzzers

WASHINGTON (AP)—The Defense Department plans in the next few months to begin tests on its household warning system, near.

A change has been made in the devices, expected to cost between \$5 and \$10, to avoid interference from electrical appliances. The buzzers would be set off by signals sent in emergencies over ordinary power lines.

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
