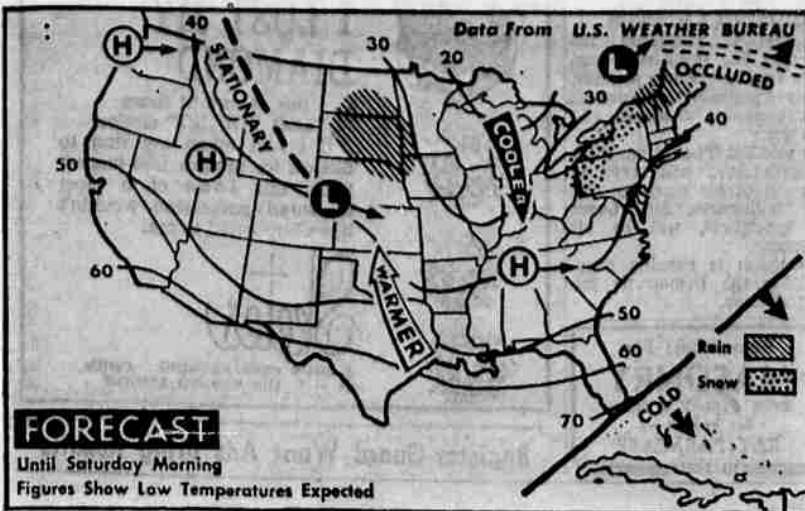




## Storm Front

## Engineers Ask Bids

Bids were invited Thursday by the Portland U.S. Army Engineer District for the second contract to be awarded for construction of the Fall Creek Dam Project.  
These bids will be construction of a reinforced concrete lower crossing bridge. The bridge will be three spans, each 60 feet long with a width of 26 feet and height of 22 feet above the riverbed. The bridge will be below the damsite.  
Recently, bids were called for relocation of a 2 1/4-mile section of the country road from the lower end of the Fall Creek crossing.  
The road bids will be opened April 26; the bridge bids, May 8.  
The dam will cost about \$27 million and will be 19 miles southeast of Eugene on Fall Creek.

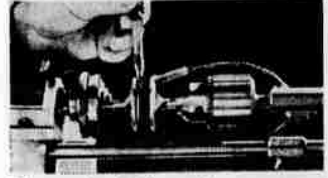
