Minister Attends Convention

The Rev. Robert M. Overgaard, pastor of the Immanuel Lutheran Brethren Church has returned from the 62nd annual convention of the Church of the Lutheran Brethren of America held in Fergus Falls, Minn., June 5-8.

The Lutheran Brethren have 60 churches in 15 northern states and part of Canada and support 50 missionaries in Japan, Africa and Formosa.

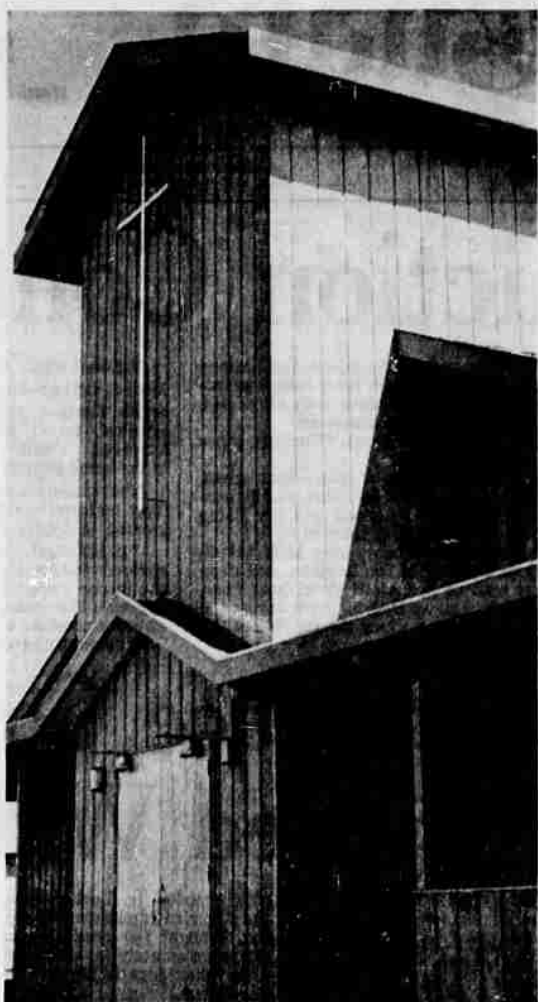
