

Gilbert Pal Also Abroad

NEW YORK (AP)—Financier Jacques Sarlie, described as an associate of runaway Wall Street executive Edward M. Gilbert, Thursday was reported in a court action also to have fled the country.

Sarlie and Gilbert were said to be associates in an attempt to gain control of Celotex Corp. Gilbert fled to Brazil June 13 after making unauthorized withdrawals of nearly \$2 million from the company he headed, E. L. Bruce Co. The money was presumed to have been withdrawn in connection with the effort to gain control of Celotex.

In State Supreme Court Thursday, the brokerage firm of McDonnell and Co. Inc. accused Sarlie of fleeing to Paris on June 9 or 10 to defraud creditors and to avoid payment of \$754,770 for stock purchased during the attempt to control Celotex.

Indian Troops Behind Red Lines

NEW DELHI (AP)—India has established four or five outposts behind the Communist Chinese lines in the disputed border areas of northern Ladakh, informed sources said Thursday.

Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru told Parliament Wednesday that the Chinese had gone on the defensive in the area and "our movements are going behind the Chinese lines."

The sources said Nehru approved forward probes by Indian border units shortly after the Indian conquest of Goa last winter.

Envoy Named

WASHINGTON (AP)—President Kennedy has named Charles E. Rhetts, a Washington attorney, as American ambassador to Liberia.

Rhetts will succeed Elbert G. Matthews, who has been reassigned to a State Department post here. Rhetts is a native of Columbus, Ohio, and was an unsuccessful Democratic congressional candidate in 1958.

'Indians' Too Real

Railroads Asked To Reduce Rates

SALEM (AP)—James E. Singleton, director of transportation for the Public Utility Commissioner, has asked the railroads to reduce transcontinental rates on potatoes shipped from Oregon.

He said their reduced rates

on potatoes shipped from eastern Idaho place Oregon shippers at a disadvantage.

He said Malheur County growers depend almost entirely on eastern markets, and that central and southern Oregon producers ship less than half of their crop eastward.

New Bridge Opened

SALONIKA, Greece (AP)—Greece and Turkey opened a million-dollar bridge Wednesday which is expected to bring a major improvement in communications between the two countries.

The bridge crosses the border Vros River at Ypsala.



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
