Emerald Empire weather being as damp as it is, the Rev. N. W. Fritz who is pastor of the Church of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Cottage Grove suggested that a protecting overhang be incorporated into plans by architects Beardsworth and Stearns of Eugene when the new building was planned. The architects found this and other suggestions useful in

designing the church. Natural woods were used for exterior and interior finish. The altar, below a canopy that conceals lights, is of white Texas limestone. The unusual "screen" behind the altar has several dozen small copper crosses to reflect light from the stained glass windows.

'A Man's Church'

Design Stresses Simplicity

EDITOR'S NOTE: Church architecture, in the Emerald Empire and throughout the United States, has led the way in the use of new architectural trends and procedures during the past few years. Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church in Cottage Grove is not "startling," architecturally, but it represents the combination of traditional and modern elements in its construction and furnishings.

COTTAGE GROVE: "An artist," Father Fritz said, "called this 'a man's church.'"

The artist, he said, was referring to the simplicity of architecture and furnishings in the new Church of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, the church just to the west of the Pacific Freeway as it passes Cottage Grove. The church was dedicated Nov. 5, and has since become a photographer's favorite. Basically traditional in structure and form, the interior and exterior finish lend themselves well to photos and scenes of angles and shadows.

If there is anything architecturally revolutionary about the church, it is its simplicity. Natural woods and materials are used throughout, and are highlighted by sparing use of stained glass and the unusual altar and canopy.

Everything is designed to focus attention on the altar, and to aid worship by 150 families.

Father Fritz—the Rev. Norbert W. Fritz, pastor—pointed out that every worshiper can see the altar. Laminated wood beams support the high, steeply pitched roof, and no other support posts are required in the sanctuary.

The traditional influence in the church is its cruciform shape—like a cross. The church has two 16-foot transepts, the side arms of the cross, which are part of the cruciform design.

Here the modern influence takes over. The stained glass windows, located in the "Ys" made by the steeply-pitched roofs of the transepts and the main sanctuary, are subdued. Colors range from blue through violet with touches of copper. All glass panels are in geometric designs.

The altar is raised on a platform, extending almost the entire 48-foot width of the sanctuary, and is enclosed on three sides by a low altar rail, which features the same simple wood design.

Episcopal Church Buys Mission Site

St. Mary's Episcopal Church has announced the purchase of five acres of land for a future mission church site in south Eugene.

The land, purchased for \$29,000, is located south of the intersection of Dillard Road and Hilyard Street. It is adjacent to land owned by the Lane Products Co.

The Rev. Steen Whiteside, rector of St. Mary's Episcopal Church, said no definite timetable has been set up for the organization of the new mission church.

At present, he said, 130 Episcopal families live in the area tentatively designated for the new parish—the area south of 29th Avenue.

The church would be the fourth Episcopal church in Eugene and the second south of the Willamette River. St. Mary's is located at 13th Avenue and Pearl Street, Eugene.

Eugene Church 110 Years Old

On July 4, the congregation of First Baptist Church of Eugene will be 110 years old.

The church's organization dates back to gatherings in a log cabin on the farm of Mahlon H. Harlow, near present-day Eugene. Harlow was the church's first deacon. The congregation met for a time in the Red Top Tavern, in a Eugene hotel. Then they moved services to a building offered by Cumberland Presbyterian Church. Its first building was ready for occupancy in 1867.

Now, the congregation numbers 2,400 persons. No special anniversary services are planned but members who joined the church from 1942-47 will be honored at the morning service Sunday.
