



Missioners Set Talk In Eugene

A missionary couple who served in the Congo until 1960, will be guest speakers Sunday at Emerald Baptist Church, 19th Avenue and Patterson Street, Eugene.

The missionaries are the Rev. and Mrs. Lewis A. Brown, now of Santa Cruz, Calif.

They began their work in the Congo in 1924, and until 1940, serving under the American Baptist Foreign Mission Society, conducted the district evangelistic and educational work at Vanga. In 1940, they were transferred to Moanza, where they worked with teacher training and education. In 1951, the couple was again transferred, this time to Kikongo district. They built a training school for village pastors there, and stayed with the station until they were evacuated during hostilities in the Congo in 1960.

Mrs. Brown will be the featured speaker Monday through Wednesday at the annual conference of the Women's Baptist Mission Society of Oregon.

The conference will be held at Linfield College, McMinnville. The theme of the conference is "Herein is Love."

Mrs. Hubert Willoughby of Eugene is in charge of an art exhibit, held in conjunction with the conference, and other Emerald Empire women will be participating.

Mrs. Frank Pattison of Eugene is president of the women's mission group.

Help From Texas

In River Road Area

Texans Help Build Church

Riviera Baptist Church, a new Southern Baptist congregation in the River Road area, is being built on a foundation of Texas draws.

And members of the new church couldn't ask for firmer construction.

Late last Saturday night, a

caravan of five cars with travel trailers pulled into Fairfield Baptist Church on Elmira Road to set up "camp." On Sunday, an enthusiastic team of 27 Texans began revival services, personal evangelism and Bible classes for youngsters in the River Road area. As a result of

their work, Riviera Baptist will begin regular services Sunday.

Unique Project

Eugene Southern Baptists believe that the project is unique in their denomination's history. The Texans are lay members of Fannin Terrace Baptist Church, Midland, Texas, and are accompanied by their pastor, the Rev. Clint Dunagan. This week's work in Eugene represents their "vacations," and was undertaken at their own expense.

The Rev. Dunagan explained that even though his church is a new congregation—two years old—it has 272 members.

Someone in the congregation suggested that a team of church members plan vacations for the same two weeks and go to the Pacific Northwest, to help establish a new church.

River Road Selected

Letters were written to the area, and River Road and the Riviera congregation were selected for the project.

The Texas church had no trouble recruiting volunteers. Team members include several professional men—engineers, a geologist, an accountant—their wives, and some bouncy young people, each of whom earned \$60 for their trip.

Some 12 youngsters from River Road turned up at Santa Clara Grange for the first day of vacation Bible School classes Monday. This number didn't satisfy the Texans, and an extensive doorbell ringing campaign brought enrollment to 55 youngsters by Wednesday.

Revival sessions at 30 Irving Rd. are having similar success.

They Like Oregon

In a few short days, Oregon has gained some enthusiastic friends.

"Oregon is wonderful," the Rev. Dunagan said. "Even the temperature is wonderful." (At home, in Midland, the thermometer is hovering around 100 degrees.)

And how is the Midland church faring, without a minister and many of its key lay people?

"I got a letter that said they did real well last Sunday," the Rev. Dunagan said. "We want to do this again next summer."
